
Let's take a moment to remember the blessings of the past year, both big and small. Each answered prayer, each moment of fellowship, each act of service – they all point to God's goodness.



#### 133 Years Fulfilling the Mission

This is a historical overview of the growth and development of the African Methodist Episcopal Church at Titusville, Florida. The intent here is to summarize the <u>significant events</u> of our church from its beginning to the present time.

#### I. Birth of the African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church

The African Methodist Church is unique in that it is the first religious body in the Western world that had its origin over sociological, rather than theological, differences. In November 1787, Richard Allen, Daniel Coker, and James Champion left St. George's Methodist Episcopal Church and formed the Free African Society. Out of the Free African Society, the African Methodist Episcopal Church was conceived.

#### II. Birth of The Florida Conference (11th Episcopal District) of the AME Church

The Florida Conference (11th Episcopal District) of the African Methodist Episcopal Church was organized in June 1867, under the leadership of Bishop A. W. Wayman, at Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church, Tallahassee, Florida.

#### III. <u>Historical Recap of St. James African Methodist Episcopal Church in Titusville, Florida</u>

Before the St. James church structure was built, blacks in Titusville held church at a 7.5-acre campground in the black community.

#### Rev. C.H. Boger Era - The Early Years (1892 - 1927)

Family members of God-fearing Brevard County African American businessmen, government workers, and citrus growers, under the leadership of Rev. C.H. Boger and Presiding Elder I. J. Harris, organized & built an African Methodist Episcopal church in Titusville, Florida, and dedicated it "Saint James".

#### Rev. C.H. Hobson Era (1927 - 1940)

Rev. C.H. Hobson oversaw the first remodeling of the church in 1927, which also included the bell and tower being moved from the east end of the church (to the west end of the church.

#### Rev. Josh W. Burno Era (1940 - 1952)

- During the early 1940s, Rev. Josh W. Burno worked with Harry T. Moore (who was murdered on Christmas night in 1951) in establishing the NAACP in the north Brevard County area in the fight for black people's right to vote in Florida's Primary Elections.
- In January 1952, Rev. Burno eulogized his friend, Harry T. Moore, who was murdered on Christmas night in 1951, and continued his work in the church and community afterward.

Notes: Beginning in the early fifties, the city of Titusville experienced a noticeable increase in population due to employment in the creation of America's Spaceport.

#### Rev. Stevenson Era (1952 - 1958)

#### Rev. J.W. Orr Era (1958 - 1960)

Rev. Orr led the building of a new edifice at the present St. James AME Church site using seed money from the sale of a 7.5-acre camparound site owned by the church.

#### Rev. Timothy P. King Era (1960 - 1962)

- Rev. Timothy P. King purchased land to move the original (wooden) parsonage (in 1961) from next to the church (on Dummtt Ave) to Wager St, thereby providing adequate space for the construction of a planned new church.
- > The King family was the first to live in the parsonage at that location.

#### Rev. Willie S. Spells Era (1962 - 1966)

- In 1962, Rev. Spells used his carpentry skills to modify the parsonage to accommodate the needs of his family.
- In 1963, Rev. Spells, acting as the contractor/builder, led the construction of the modern St. James church sanctuary, which was completed/dedicated in 1964.
- Rev. Spells' wife, Sis. Hattie Spells and others, such as Sis. Mary Lee Harvey and Sis. Richard Mae Fayson led the St. James Missionary Society to new heights in the District.
- In 1966, the new sanctuary mortgage was paid in full. And a copy of the church mortgage was burned in a well-attended ceremony that included the AME Bishop.

#### Rev. C. D Dixon Era (1966 - 1971)

- Rev. C. D Dixon led the construction of the present-day St. James brick parsonage (which was built south of the original wooden church parsonage) on Wager Avenue.
  - The original wooden church parsonage was subsequently torn down.
- ➤ In 1971, the church purchased two lots on Wager Street adjoining the parsonage.

#### Rev. Walter S. White Era (1971 - 1972)

> The Normans and Hattie Gilbert's home, located across the street from the church, was purchased to serve as an annex for the church.

#### Rev. Jerome L. Denmark Era (1972 - 1976)

- The church annex was developed further, and a concession area in the rear southeast of the sanctuary was converted into the church office during the mid-1970s.
- The first church male usher board (attired in matching suits) was originated.

#### Rev. Jessie Haywood Era (1976 - 1979)

#### Rev. Dr. Edoras Page Era (1979 - 1983)

- The front entrance of the church was beautified by adding A canopy, steps, and wrought iron railings. Lawson Construction performed the front entrance beautification.
- The church pews were upholstered, and the pulpit area was expanded to accommodate the musical instruments.
- The James Hawkins Canaveral Avenue property was purchased to add church parking.

In the seventies & eighties, the Space Shuttle program brought in quite a few people working in high-paying jobs. The overall economic situation in Brevard County improved considerably.

#### Rev. D. Luther Bell Era #1 (1983 - 1989)

- Church indebtedness was consolidated, and the James Hawkins property was purchased and converted into a cement parking lot.
- Ethel Brooks' home site, located next door to the church, was purchased, and a van was purchased for the transportation ministry.
- Mrs. Richard Mae Fayson's long-held dream to install a pictorial representation of the founding of the AME Church in dedication to the memory of St. James builder Rev. Willie E. Spells came to fruition through raised funds, which were used to remove the two existing stained-glass windows and create one large new stained-glass window.

#### Rev George Young Era (1989 - 1990)

#### THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FELLOWSHIP HALL

#### Rev. Elvin J. Parker Era (1990 - 1995)

- Rev. Elvin J. Parker planted the vision of constructing a church fellowship hall in the minds of the membership and led the purchase of the Preston Thomas and Roderick Harris properties located on the Westside of Dummitt Avenue for church expansion.
- Major parsonage renovations were completed during Rev Parker's tenure.

#### Rev. D. Luther Bell Era #2 (1995 - 2006)

The Orlando, Florida, Conference of 1994 made a historical act by assigning the Rev. D. Luther as pastor of St. James AME Church for a second time.

- > Rev. Bell led the construction of the Fellowship Hall, with the motto "Mission Possible". Increased membership giving and creative private financing, facilitated by Nehemiah Consulting Group project funding, were all key to funding the half-million-dollar project.
- Hosea Williams, the Trustee Board Chairman Pro-Tem, led fundraising to purchase additional property needed to build the Fellowship Hall.
- The general contractor, Johnny Archer Construction Company of Palm Bay, Florida, started construction in December 1999 and completed construction in September 2000.
- The Pulpit Aid Board, led by Dr. George L. Fayson, Sr., refurbished the church annex and installed blinds and draperies.

#### INTRODUCTION TO AN ERA OF CHANGE

#### Rev. Glenn B. Dames, Jr. Era (2006 - 2016)

Rev. Glenn Dames, Jr.'s 10-year pastorship was the longest continuous St. James AME Church appointment.

- Church attendance and membership increased -including many new youth and young adults members' involved in Christian training and social outlets such as: the Chastity Program and Ceremony which included over eighty (80) boys and girls; Tutorial and computer programs, Social dances, with the moto; "All clean, all fun all to the glory"; Brother to Brother mentoring; Praise Dancing; Youth Ride-Out; Back to school bash; and Sons of Thunder, to name a few.
- Professional inspirational musicians were hired and (1) created the 'theme song Welcome to St. James' and (2) organized well-attended St. James Christmas Cantatas.
- The sanctuary was remodeled, including the replacement of the chancel rail; new carpeting & church pews; and a new linked church/ Fellowship Hall video system.
- Rev. Dames served as president of the local branch of the N.A.A.C.P; was as a member of the Parks & Recreation Board, established Souls to the Polls for early black voting, was the Go-to' person for addressing community racial issues, and created the (elegant) Annual Onyx Awards Program to recognize and honor community members in several categories.

Note: The loss of jobs after the Space Shuttle Program ended in 2011 affected St. James AME Church.

#### Rev. A.J. Davis Era (2016 - 2022)

Three significant events during this era were: (1) the purchase of a new church van and (2) the \$78,000.00 church roof replacement campaign led by two stewards -Sis. Juanita Houston & Bro. Art Edwards (3) St. James remained #2 in the Daytona Beach District.

Note: Following the onset of the Global COVID-19 Pandemic in March 2020, Face-to-face church services were discontinued for approximately 2 years, and Church services and church school were held via Zoom.

#### Dr. Rev Roy Jones, Jr. Era (2022 - Present)

- Rev. Jones (1) brought a wealth of 'religious leadership experience' and history to St. James (2) created a 'Vision' of Spiritual Growth, and (3) placed focus on congregation restoration, Effective Church Leadership, and Fiscal Responsibility. His media use is very effective in reaching a large audience of St. James members and other Christians across multiple states. He creates YouTube videos that are inspirational and effective biblical teaching tools. Daily early morning scriptural learning and prayer sessions are well attended and provide structured devotional biblical teaching.
- From 2022 to 2025, church membership and Sunday attendance have increased. Emphasis has been placed on financial management and reducing church indebtedness through increased giving, fundraising, and the sale of unused/unneeded property. Capable and involved church officers have effectively shared in church leadership.
- Rev. Jones is 'very active' in terms of caring for his membership and others in the community, maintaining awareness of individual situations, and taking actions to assist when appropriate. His visits to check on the sick and shut-ins are uplifting and appreciated.
- Significant 2022-2025 achievements include major work at the St. James parsonage, including facility renovation and roof replacement; drain line replacement (2), six air conditioner units replaced (in the sanctuary and fellowship hall, and fully paid off).
