As a Linux Administrator, monitors systems performance and ensures compliance with security standards. Monitors everyday systems, evaluates availability of all server resources, and performs all activities for Linux servers. Assists with configuring and deploying all virtual machines and installs and provides backup to all configuration procedures. Maintains and monitors all patch releases, designs various patch installation strategies, and maintains all systems according to NIST standards.
