Ready to ZOOM!


Our participants are 18 and over---and have generally exited K-12 education. We currently provide high quality programs in three areas: Day Treatment, Transition to Employment Training and Employment Services.

2020 was anything but typical! However, our participants (and our staff) learned how to adapt and become resilient as we created new delivery methods for our programs in 2020-2021. We kept the learning and engagement going strong with a small cadre of (socially distant and mask wearing) participants in our facility, as well as a full (and growing) roster of online participants via ZOOM.


