# THE GREAT SQUEAKY EXPERIMENT by Susan Hervey and Sarah Helber

Have you ever wondered if the squeakers that only dogs can hear actually squeak?

"Miles" and Sarah Helber conducted a Squeak fest experiment. Mile received a dog toy with a squeaker that "only dogs can hear" for his birthday. While he seemed to enjoy it, it wasn't any more special than the other toys he played with that had fairly subdued squeakers.

Miles definitely prefers very loud (and VERY ANNOYING) squeakers! The human element prefers quieter squeakers!



Sarah had recently downloaded an app to her phone called "Birdnet" that records, analyzes and ID's birdsongs in the wild. It works by showing a spectrogram of the sound while it is recording. The user can then select a portion of the spectrogram and send it to be analyzed using artificial intelligence. We wondered if it could tell us if the squeaker actually squeaked.


When reporting the result of the analysis the app gives the species of bird singing, along with an estimate ranging from "almost certain" down to "highly uncertain" of the likelihood that it is indeed that bird.

At first we tried recording while Miles was squeaking it. Sarah had to laugh at the answer - the app said "probably human!" She didn't know that was even a possible answer. However, it was encouraging that it recorded and analyzed something.


Then Susan squeaked it according to the number of fingers Sarah held up - squeaking twice, then four times, then three times. The spectrogram clearly showed a distinctive sound in sets of 2, 4, and 3.

So--the toy actually makes a sound that the app can hear! We can probably also assume that dogs can hear it. Of course it is possible it was analyzing the "squeeze" sound rather than the "squeak" sound.

From Miles reaction, however, I'd have to say it might not be one of the really loud squeakers!
