PORTIA DZIFA DZILA

Portia Dzifa Dzila is a teacher at the Pakro Anglican Basic School in the Akwapem South District of the Eastern Region of Ghana. Pakro is a farming community hence there has been a common challenge of truancy, teenage pregnancy, and low school enrollment for basic school learners especially girls. Portia took up the challenge and has dedicated her life to transforming the lives of her students and their families.

She believes every child deserves a chance to succeed, no matter the obstacles. Through her efforts and as a 21st century teacher, through her personal resources and leveraging social media, she has raised funds to buy school uniforms and shoes for over 800 students and provided exercise books and other learning materials for kindergarten children. Her goal is to ensure that all children, especially girls, have access to education. Her kindness has reached many families. She helped find a sponsor for a primary school girl on the verge of dropping out, ensuring she could stay in school. She also raised money to help two parents send their daughters to Senior High School and continues to support the girls to this day.

One boy in her school often skipped classes because he didn't have enough to eat - a common phenomenon. Portia stepped in and started feeding him every day. This simple act of kindness kept him in school, and he has now successfully completed. Another girl, facing family issues that threatened her education, is now living with a supportive family in Accra and attending Senior High School—all thanks to Portia's intervention. During the BECE exams, Portia goes beyond her teaching duties. She travels with her candidates to another community, where they sleep in classrooms for the week, ensuring they are supported and ready to perform their best. After the exams, she brings them together for a special event called the "Feast of Togetherness," hosted at her home. It's a time to celebrate their hard work, bond as a group, and receive guidance for the future. This act of love yearly has made Portia a household name in the community. Portia also leads the school's Gender Club, where she empowers students with practical skills like soap making and crafts. She educates girls about the importance of staying in school and also guides boys on how to grow into responsible adults. Even after school hours, she stays behind to tutor struggling students, helping them catch up academically.

For over a decade, Portia has been more than a teacher at Pakro Anglican Basic School. She is a mentor, a caregiver, and a beacon of hope for her community. Her dedication to improving education, reducing teenage pregnancy, and creating opportunities for students makes her an inspiring figure in the Eastern Region of Ghana. She recently was adjudged the Global winner as well as the Regional Winner for Sub-Saharan Africa of the 2025-Cambridge Dedicated Teacher Awards.

Professor Eric Yirenkyi Danquah (BSc, University of Ghana; MPhil & PhD, University of Cambridge, UK) is a distinguished plant geneticist and institution builder whose work has reshaped education and agricultural innovation in Africa. He is the Founding Director of the West Africa Centre for Crop Improvement (WACCI), established at the University of Ghana in 2007. Under his leadership, WACCI has enrolled more than 160 PhD and 60+ Master's students from nearly 20 African countries. Its alumni have released over 290 improved crop varieties, mobilized more than US\$62 million for their institutions, and assumed leadership positions across national agricultural research systems. In addition, Professor Danquah's philosophy of "training Africans, for Africa, in Africa" has been central to reversing brain drain, promoting equity, and creating opportunities for young scientists. All of this provides clear evidence of scalable impact in Africa.

This impactful person's contributions extend beyond training other Africans. He pioneered the development of Ghana's first high-yielding hybrid maize varieties and led efforts in

tomato breeding, advancing food and nutrition security. He was also the inaugural President of the African Plant Breeders Association from 2019 to 2023, giving continental recognition to the profession. Furthermore, Professor Danquah currently chairs the Governing Board of the Ghana National Research Fund, where he shapes science financing and policy. He has published more than 200 refereed papers, and served on advisory panels with CGIAR, FAO, IFAD, and other global institutions.

Due to his leadership and innovation,

Professor Danquah received the GCHERA World Agriculture Prize (2018), the Africa Food Prize (2022), and recognition among the 100 Most Reputable Africans (2023 and 2024). By combining research excellence, institutional leadership, and policy engagement, Professor Danquah has created enduring systems for education and innovation that continue to benefit Ghana, Africa, and the world.

PROFILE

Professor Chinedu Ositadimma Nebo

A distinguished scholar, administrator, and reformer, Professor Nebo's professional journey spans over four decades of academic and public service. He has the rare distinction of serving as Vice-Chancellor in three distinct institutions—the University of Nigeria, Nsukka (UNN), the Federal University Oye-Ekiti (FUOYE), and the University on the Niger—each of which bears indelible marks of his intellectual clarity, moral authority, and strategic foresight. His tenure in these roles redefined institutional culture, improved governance standards, and expanded access to quality education.

Beyond academia, Professor Nebo's intellectual and ethical depth earned him national recognition when he was appointed as Nigeria's Federal Minister of Power, where he brought scholarly precision, moral discipline, and policy innovation to the task of modernizing the nation's power sector. His transition from the university to the federal cabinet was not a departure from education, but a continuation of his lifelong mission—to apply knowledge as an instrument for national transformation.

What distinguishes Professor Nebo is not only the offices he has held but the transformative outcomes he consistently delivers. His leadership style harmonizes intellectual excellence with spiritual grounding, administrative precision with human compassion, and innovation with moral responsibility. Through strategic reforms, infrastructural expansion, and the empowerment of academic and administrative personnel, he has demonstrated that education remains the surest pathway to Africa's sustainable development.

It is on this foundation of proven leadership, institutional reform, and national contribution that this nomination is advanced. Professor Chinedu Ositadimma Nebo exemplifies the ideals of African educational transformation—visionary leadership, innovative spirit, inclusive governance, and enduring legacy. The following seven frameworks—Leadership and Influence; Innovation and Creativity; Impact and Reach; Advocacy and Policy Contribution; Equity and Inclusion; Sustainability and Scalability; and Research, Mentorship, and Knowledge Sharing—collectively capture the breadth and depth of his transformative contributions to education and national development.

1. Leadership and Influence

Professor Chinedu Ositadimma Nebo stands as one of Africa's most distinguished higher education leaders. His rare record of serving as Vice-Chancellor of three universities—the University of Nigeria, Nsukka; Federal University Oye-Ekiti (FUOYE); and presently, the University on the Niger—demonstrates a consistent pattern of trust, excellence, and institutional transformation. Each tenure was marked by visionary leadership that elevated institutional governance, expanded academic infrastructure, and revitalized staff and student morale. Beyond the university sphere, his appointment as Nigeria's Federal Minister of Power further affirms the breadth of his leadership influence. Under his Vice-Chancellorship, UNN and FUYOYE witnessed remarkable improvements in academic performance, infrastructural growth, and international partnerships. At the University of Nigeria, Nsukka, Professor Nebo's legacy in infrastructural transformation remains nothing short of legendary. With visionary determination and administrative prudence, he resurrected and completed the 7,500-seater Nnamdi Azikiwe Library Complex—a monumental academic facility that had been abandoned for over two decades. This singular achievement not only restored the university's intellectual heartbeat but also symbolized a renaissance of learning and scholarship at one of Africa's oldest universities. Equally remarkable, Professor Nebo constructed fifteen state-of-the-art faculty lecture theatres, all financed solely from internally generated revenue—an unprecedented feat in Nigeria's public university system. This accomplishment stands as enduring testimony to his financial integrity, creative resource mobilization, and transparent stewardship. Through these transformative projects, Professor Nebo redefined what visionary university leadership could achieve, proving that disciplined management and moral leadership can indeed turn scarcity into abundance. His ministerial leadership extended this influence nationally, where he spearheaded energy reforms that underscored the role of knowledge in development. His reach is both quantitative—in the number of lives impacted—and qualitative—in the enduring institutional legacies he has built.

4. Advocacy and Policy Contribution

Professor Nebo's advocacy for academic integrity, meritocracy, and reform is unmatched. As Vice-Chancellor, he advanced policies that strengthened research, funding, and governance. As Federal Minister of Power, he promoted knowledge-based energy policy, bridging academia and governance. Also, when he promoted Dr. Pamela Enemuoh and Dr. Felicia Monye to the rank of Professor of Law, he demonstrated equity and inclusion for qualified females. At FUYOYE, he fostered community engagement programmes that bridged town and gown divides and expanded access to educational opportunities. His vision of leadership is inclusive, ensuring that no group or individual is left behind.

6. Sustainability and Scalability

A hallmark of Professor Nebo's leadership is sustainability through systems building. He prioritizes capacity development, policy continuity, and leadership succession. His governance structures at UNN and FUYOYE remain functional years after his tenure, demonstrating scalability and resilience. His reforms provide replicable models for institutional transformation across Africa. For example, FUYOYE which he pioneered as the Vice Chancellor, emerged as the the fifth most preferred University of destination during the 2025 Joint Admission Matriculation Board Policy Meeting chaired by Nigeria's Federal Minister of Education.

7. Research, Mentorship, and Knowledge Sharing

Professor Nebo is a consummate scholar and mentor. His academic work links scientific inquiry with ethical leadership. He has supervised many postgraduate students who now hold leadership roles globally. Through lectures, conferences, and mentorship, he continually shares knowledge and inspires the next generation of African scholars and leaders. Beyond infrastructure, Professor Nebo's influence radiated through people. His leadership nurtured excellence, inspired loyalty, and produced a generation of capable academic leaders. No fewer than a dozen academics who served under his administration have since been appointed Vice-Chancellors in various Nigerian universities—a living legacy of mentorship, capacity building, and leadership replication. 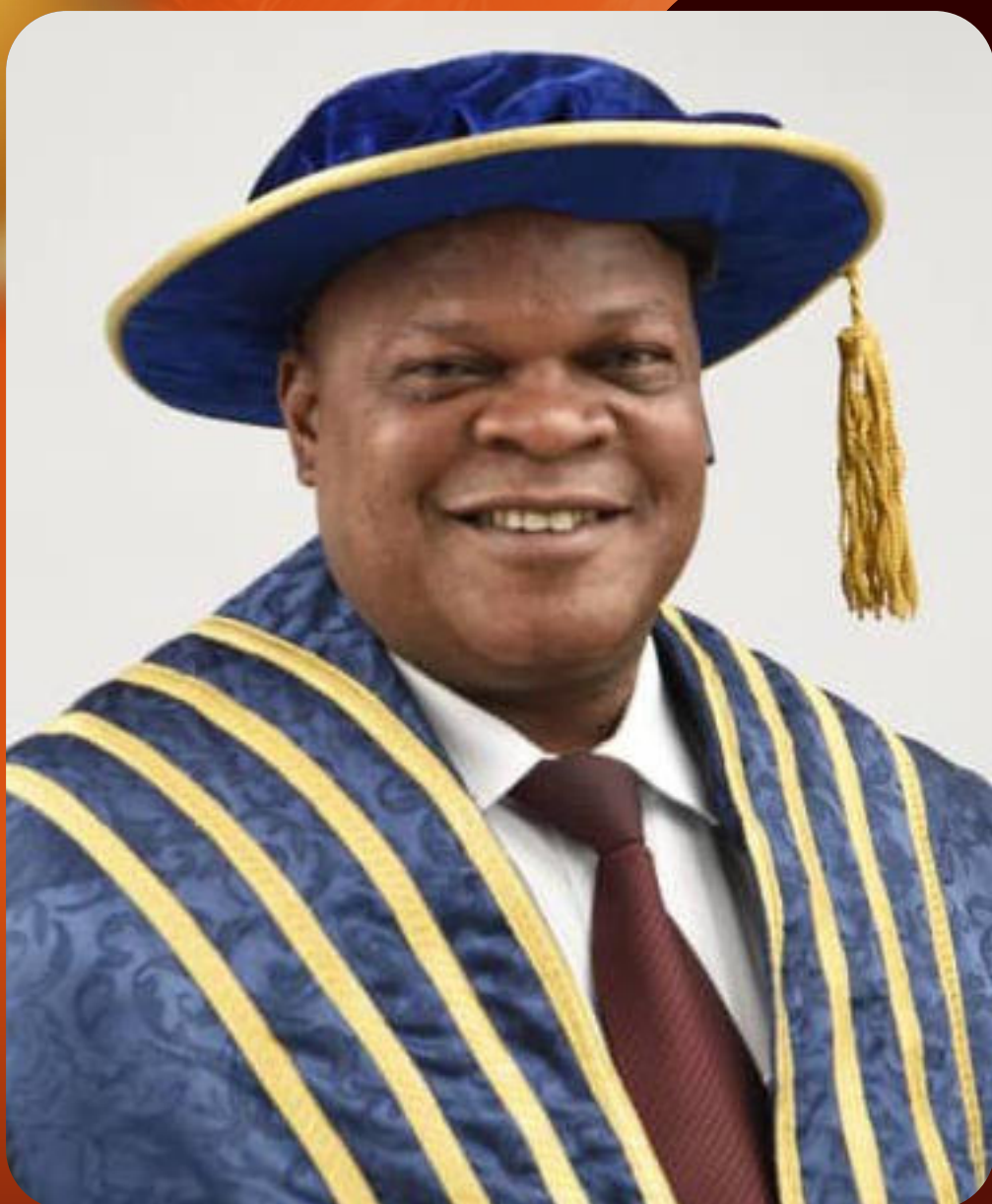

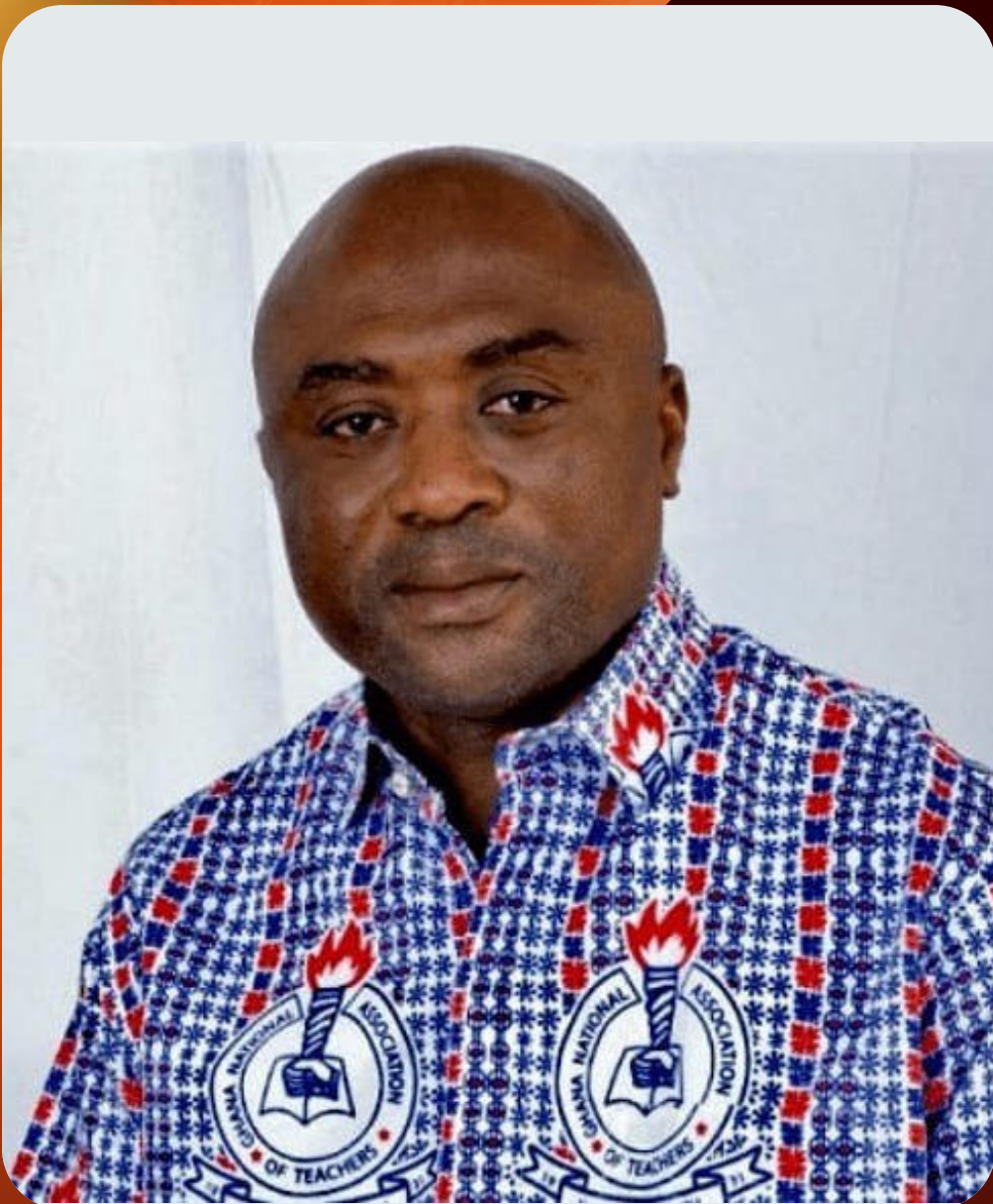

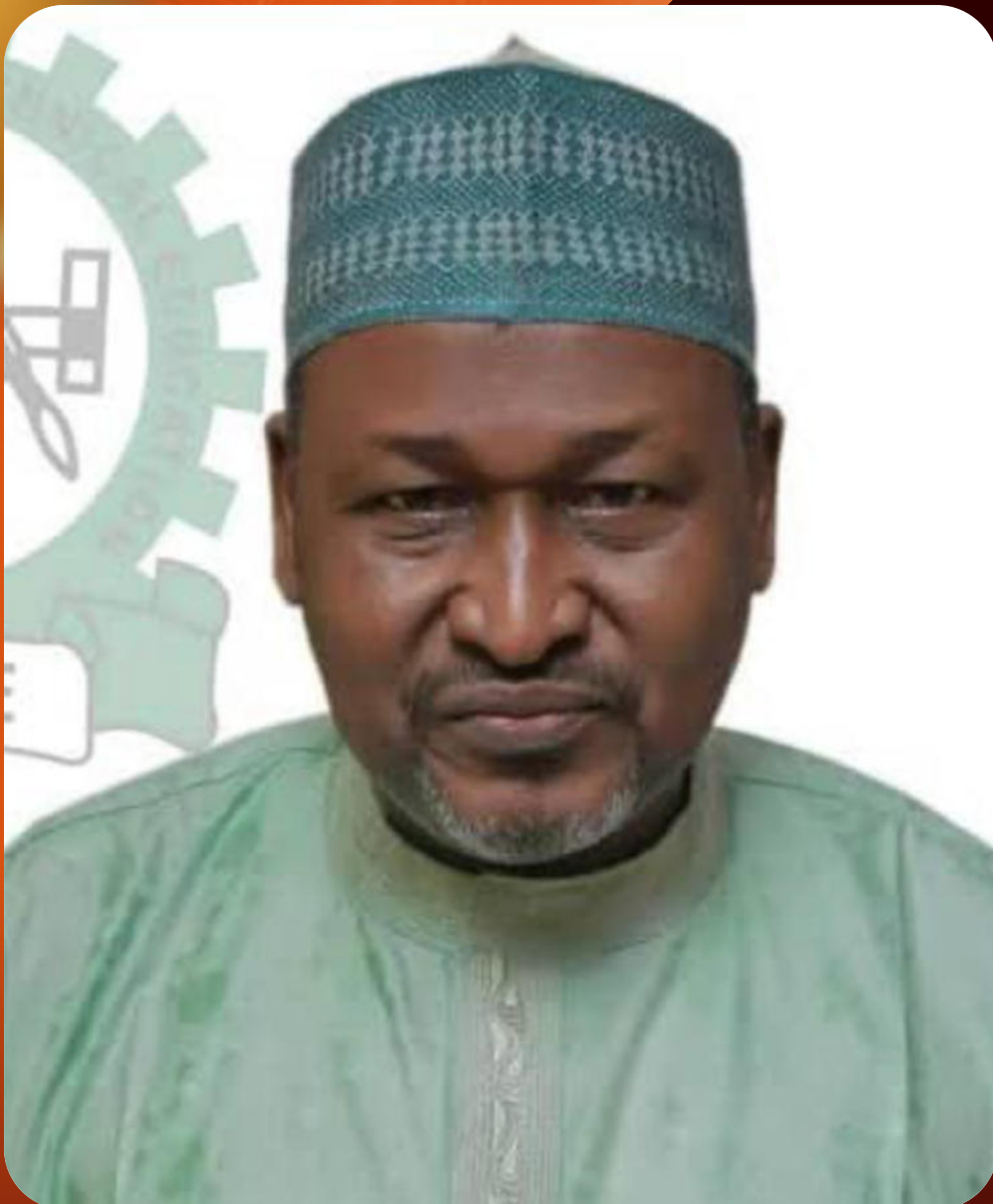

Valérie Joëlle KOUAM NGOCKA

Valérie Joëlle Kouam Ngocka is a Cameroonian teacher, novelist, consultant, coach, and translator.

Her impact on education stems from her roles:

- 1) Language teacher, particularly of Italian, at several higher education institutions in Cameroon.
- 2) Director of ICLY (Institute of Culture and Languages, Yaoundé)
- 3) President of the FEVAH Foundation
- 4) Personal Development Coach

Career Path and Educational Impact

Italian Language Teacher: Valérie Joëlle Kouam Ngocka has taught Italian at the University of Yaoundé I, the University of Dschang, UCAC Yaoundé (Catholic University of Central Africa), the University of Douala, Esugmeg, and the ICLY Professional Training Center. As a university professor, she trains numerous students in the mastery of Italian language and culture, thus contributing to their academic and professional development.

Translator: She also works as a translator. This dual role allows her to offer linguistic and intercultural expertise, which benefits her students and readers. Translation is a field that demands a nuanced understanding of linguistic and cultural differences, skills she likely imparts in her teaching.

Author: As a novelist, she contributes to education through literature. Her first novel, *À cause d'elle* (Because of Her), published in 2011, explores social and cultural themes by immersing readers in the life of an ordinary family in Cameroon. This type of work can be used as a teaching tool to introduce students to Cameroonian literature, sociology, and issues of cultural heritage.

Literary Work: À cause d'elle

Summary: The novel tells the story of young Djuidjé and her grandmother Gotam, immersed in everyday family life. An incident involving a suspected theft leads to the unexpected discovery of a lost family heirloom. The plot depicts the clash between tradition and modernity, superstition and religious faith.

Educational Value: The novel has educational value as a literary work that can be studied in courses on African literature or sociology. It raises questions about respect for traditions, conformity, and the

pursuit of freedom. In short, Valérie Joëlle Kouam Ngocka has made a significant impact on education in Cameroon as a university professor and translator, but also as an author, offering her readers and students a literary perspective on important social and cultural issues.

Consultant and Coach: Since the early 2000s, this seasoned teacher has offered anyone who wishes to do so the opportunity to test and certify their language skills. She is a pioneer in providing personal development courses, coaching, and monitoring to learners at the Language Center she founded and directs. Understanding the importance of supporting individuals' development, she has focused on methods that lead to self-knowledge. She instills in and helps many young people to bring out the best version of themselves and to build a strong and positive mindset. Thousands of young people train at ICLY and leave equipped with the transformative power of the education they receive and absorb. Their feedback and testimonials are proof of this.

With over 23 years of experience, she has dedicated her time to encouraging young people by creating training programs in entrepreneurship and youth empowerment, as well as introductory computer skills. These initiatives have allowed various segments of society to access education (including displaced persons from the Northwest and Southwest regions), thus democratizing it.

By awarding scholarships to numerous young people, the foundation she leads reveals a vision of education that emphasizes the importance of transmitting knowledge, but above all, of awakening in learners the desire to care for others and to serve.

Through the activities offered by the foundation, it is easy to see a revolutionary initiative that unveils a simple and compelling approach. The role of culture is highlighted by film screenings followed by discussions, which students thoroughly enjoy, as well as excursions and visits to underprivileged communities. This educator deeply believes that every person is capable of making a special and unique contribution to building the world. They simply need the opportunity by being provided with a healthy, stimulating, and supportive environment.

Founder of the Association Tia, she develops social and educational projects for vulnerable communities. Recognized for her collaborative and visionary approach, she works to make education and diplomacy pillars of an inclusive, resilient Africa oriented toward the future.

An alumna of the Women Leadership Academy (Class of 2023, Fondation Aga Khan), she strengthens her leadership skills and shares her knowledge, convinced that education and the sharing of knowledge are the keys to transformative leadership. This experience has strengthened her commitment to pass on knowledge and to build inclusive learning spaces.

NOUR Fahad

Born on March 5, 1985, in the Comoros, Mr. Fahad Nour embodies the image of a new African generation deeply committed to transforming education through innovation and digital technology. After completing a full academic journey in his home country (Bachelor's degree in Geography), he pursued his studies in France, where he earned a Master's degree in Spatial Planning and Territorial Development from the University of La Réunion, followed by a dual Master's degree in Primary Education and in Educational Sciences. He is currently a doctoral candidate at CURAPP, preparing a PhD in Educational Sciences, scheduled for defense in November 2025.

Since 2016, Mr. Nour has laid the foundations for a sustainable educational transformation in the Comoros and East Africa. A visionary, he founded the association #ComoresTice, the first initiative in the country to train teachers in digital education. Through this initiative, more than 276 primary school teachers were trained free of charge in the use of educational technologies between 2017 and 2025. The association also equipped 18 schools with computer equipment and more than 25 rural libraries with the Pédagobox_Comoros—an innovative, locally made, solar powered device capable of storing up to 20,000 digitized books and learning resources.

Always at the forefront, in 2018 he organized the first international conference on digital technology and education in the Comoros, marking a turning point in national discussions on pedagogical practices. At the same time, he led the country's first major national survey on young people's use of social media and published a book the same year (Comorian Youth in the Digital Era and Social Transformations), offering solutions for an ethical and responsible use of the internet and social media. Mr. Nour also stands out through his fieldwork: he collected and shipped 68,000 school textbooks in collaboration with the French association Livres Sans Frontières, thereby providing many Comorian schools and libraries with essential pedagogical resources that were previously lacking.

In 2024, he developed an innovative educational model: the 4R Concept (Realization, Regulation, Feedback, and Recap). Inspired by the works of Vygotsky, Piaget, and Bruner, this model fosters student autonomy and collaborative learning. Already being implemented in the Comoros, Cameroon, and Madagascar, it is gaining increasing interest among African teachers eager to adapt their practices to local realities. That same year, he co-authored the "Pedagogical Guide for Primary School Teachers in the Comoros", an unprecedented reference enriched with a USB key of practical resources, written in collaboration with a former dean of the National Education Inspectorate.

Mr. Nour's commitment extends far beyond the Comoros. In 2024, he founded Africa Digital & Education in Rwanda, a company that supports students across several countries (Comoros, Rwanda, Madagascar, Morocco, Senegal, France, and others) in preparing dissertations, internship reports, and professional integration. In less than a year, this initiative has become a key platform for fostering academic success and employability among African youth.

In parallel, in 2022 he launched the MNUD Roundtable, a free annual event held during the Global Entrepreneurship Week. It brings together experts and students eager to combine academic studies with entrepreneurial projects. This platform already inspires dozens of young Africans to embark on entrepreneurial ventures while pursuing their studies.

Today, despite his multiple responsibilities—doctoral candidate, teacher in the French national education system, head of two companies (Africa Digital & Education and Nour Fahad Sarl), and founder of #ComoresTice—Mr. Fahad Nour remains faithful to his mission: to democratize access to quality education that is inclusive and adapted to African realities. Through his academic achievements, pedagogical innovations, and unwavering commitment to education, he stands out as one of the most influential figures of his generation. His work reflects the conviction that education is the cornerstone of development, and his impact in East Africa and beyond fully justifies his place among the 100 Most Influential Personalities in the Education Sector in Africa.

Her doctoral research investigated the Earth's geomagnetic field with an emphasis on its variability and modeling, addressing impacts on infrastructure and industrial applications. Currently, she coordinates the bachelor's program in engineering physics of signals and systems and serves as an associate professor at the University of Antananarivo, where she combines advanced research on space weather phenomena with innovative teaching. Her work extends to the study of geomagnetic storms and their effects on technological systems, contributing both to scientific knowledge and practical mitigation strategies in Madagascar and the region.

Dr. Razafindranaivo has conducted international collaborative projects including postdoctoral research in Romania, visiting researcher stays in Mexico and India, fostering knowledge transfer and scientific cooperation in space weather and geomagnetism fields. Prior to Academic City, he was an Associate Professor and Founding Dean of Engineering at Ashesi University and served on the Executive Leadership Team as well as on the Academic Council.

Prof. McBagonluri have had a distinguished career as a hands-on and progressive innovator in corporate America working at senior levels for Siemens Healthcare, Becton, Dickinson & Co., and Joerns Healthcare. He pioneered innovative products development and manufacturing processes leading to over \$250M in new markets.

He led a team at Siemens Healthcare that delivered the first direct consumer medical product designed and manufactured using digital manufacturing protocols. He has written over 40 US patents and patent applications with over 20 issued patents.
