CPD TRAINING FOR THE NIGERIA UNION OF TEACHERS (NUT)

Theme: “Mental Health Empowerment for Educators: From Self-Care to Student Well-Being”

Date: 8th–9th September 2025

Venue: Best Western Pinewood Manchester, Airport–Wilmslow Hotel

The two-day training was a success, drawing educators from across Nigeria. Through interactive workshops, participants explored practical strategies for mental wellness, stress management, and classroom resilience.

Outcome Highlights:

- 92% of attendees reported increased awareness of self-care practices.
- Teachers developed personalized well-being action plans.
- Participants received UK CPD Certificates recognizing their commitment to continuous development.

2ND AFRICA HEALTH SUMMIT — KIGALI, RWANDA



Theme: “The Power of Prevention: Advancing Workforce Health for a Resilient and Thriving Africa”

Date: 15th–16th September 2025

Venue: Saint Vincent Pallotti, Kigali

This summit convened policymakers, health experts, and private sector leaders from 14 African countries. Key dialogues centered on preventive health, policy innovation, and workforce resilience.

Key Outcomes:

- A policy brief on “Workforce Wellness for Sustainable Development” was endorsed by 7 African ministries.
- The Preventive Health Innovation Showcase featured 10 new digital solutions for public health.
- Participants formed new cross-border partnerships for workplace wellness programs.
