
I found him a very hardworking, disciplined, and ambitious senior.

He was the youngest Chief Medical Director of the UCTH when he successfully delivered the project that led to the migration to the new teaching hospital (UCTH.)

Academically, Prof. Ndoma-Egba has many publications and has trained many professors in his speciality.

Administratively; he established the Institute of Tropical Medicine and Research, Faculty of Dentistry at UNICAL/UNICAL TEACHING HOSPITAL. He also established a research journal, "Mary Slessor Journal of



Medicine."

He was appointed the Pro-chancellor and Chairman of the Council at The OAU, Ile-Ife. It was during this time that the Queen of England, Elizabeth II, received him and other heads of commonwealth universities at Buckingham Palace in 2013.

In the Society at large,he has been Chairman of the Red Cross Society, Nigeria Cancer Society (CR), 15yrs, and Chairman of Dysability sports for 20 yrs.

He is a very distinguished Almunus of our School, Government Secondary School Afikpo, and of the University of Lagos. A Valedictorian of the University of Lagos Medical School. In 1979 he won Honours as the best National Youth Service Corp member while serving in the then Gongola state. Nigeria. Prof Salami is the Vice President of the Association of African Universities and a traditional title holder of the Oganete of Igarra Land and YeyeMeso of Ondo Kingdom. PROF. OPUDA ALIOMA EKINE



ABIGAIL OSEREMEN OKPEBHOLO

South South Nigeria Advocacy Award



Abigail Oseremen Okpebholo is a passionate women and girls rights advocate, public speaker, and community mobilizer with over a decade of experience working to improve the lives and promote the rights of women and girls in rural communities across underserved communities in Delta State, Nigeria. She is a dedicated champion for girls' access to quality education in underserved regions working to combat child marriage, and reintegrate former child brides into school.

She is the Founder and Chief Eexecutive Officer of

Youngpearl Women and Girls Initiative, a Delta-based nonprofit organisation that influence policies to protect girls' rights at the grassroots level. Through her Back2School Intervention, which she launched in 2012, she works to improve access to education for underprivileged girls and has provided scholarships covering tuition, uniforms, books, writing materials and other essential school supplies for over 6,500 underprivileged girls both thos at-risk of child marriage and former child brides, enabling them learn without hassle. This intervention has directly halted over 500 child marriages and reintegrated more than 1,500 former child brides into school.

In addition, Abigail is the Founder and Co-Director of Sunrise Academy, a holistic learning center established in 2017 that provides quality education, safe learning spaces, mentorship, and after-school tutorials to underprivileged girls, particularly reintegrated former child brides. Under her leadership, the academy has empowered over 500 girls, equipping them with essential skills and knowledge to secure a brighter future.

Furthermore, realising that menstruation was a significant factor that keep girls away from school, she launched the #ProjectEndPeriodPoverty in 2018 to end period poverty among adolescent girls in rural communities across the UDU region, improve school attendance and reduce menstrual related absenteeism. Through this project, she has distributed menstrual hygiene kits to over 4,500 adolescent school girls, carried out menstrual health education in over 30 rural secondary schools and worked with traditional leaders and faithbased organisations to implement menstrual hygiene programs in over 8 rural communities in Delta State. This has drastically reduced the use of unsafe and unhygienic menstrual alternatives such as papers, rags, and leaves, improved school attendance and drastically

reduced harmful menstrual related practices.

Also, recognising the role men and boys play in community matters, she launched the Menstrual Health and Hygiene Boys' Talk Series in 2024 to engage males in advocating for menstrual health awareness. Through this talk series, she has reached over 2,000 males who are all joining hands to end menstrual poverty in their communities and work spaces.

Beyond her organizational leadership, Abigail has made significant contributions to global education advocacy. From 2015 to 2018, she worked with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) Nigeria as an Enrollment Drive Campaign Officer, where she played a pivotal role in increasing girls school enrollment by designing and implementing the first-ever Enrollment Drive Campaign (EDC), spearheaded the inauguration of EDC committees in over 50 underserved communities, facilitated over 100 sensitization programs and workshops for inaugurated local EDC committees members.

Currently, she serves as a Board Member at CRIO, an international organization committed to improving the lives of orphans, particularly girls, through education. In her role, she shapes policies that support the educational needs of orphaned girls, spearheads report writing, strategic planning, and ensure that funds are appropriately allocated for the needs of the orphans.

Due to her extraordinary work, she has won numerous awards which includes the 2021 Impactfield Exceptional Youth Award, 2020 Winner, GirlRising and HP Storytelling Challenge and was a finalist in the 2020 Nigeria's Citizenship for Education Award.

Her wok has also been featured in several international blogs, websites and podcasts.

Abigail holds a Bachelor of Science in Microbiology from Delta State University, Abraka, Nigeria. She leverages her strong analytical and problem-solving skills to drive social impact, strengthen grassroots communities, and amplify the voices of women and girls across Delta State, Nigeria.

In the Society at large, he has been Chairman of the Red




