Southwest Nigeria Lives Development Award

Dr (Mrs.) Margaret Fagboyo is a Multi-disciplinary Development Practitioner with demonstrated experience in International Development, Gender Mainstreaming and Institutional Partnerships.

She currently serves as the Director of Development at the African Centre for Leadership, Strategy & Development (Centre LSD), a leading international NGO and think tank in Nigeria dedicated to building strategic leadership for sustainable development in Africa. Previously, She was a member of the Ekiti State Executive Council as Special Adviser to the Ekiti State Governor on Development Partnerships and SDGs, with responsibility for coordinating Bilateral and Multilateral Interventions and Partnerships and Coordination and Management of the SDGs in the State.

She has a Masters Degree in Public Administration and International Affairs from the University of Lagos and a First Degree from the University of Ado Ekiti, in Guidance & Counselling (Second Class Upper Division). Nigeria nominated her for Director-General of the OPCW; she brings nearly four decades of experience combining scientific insight with diplomacy.

Industry & Article VI Cluster, and Chair of the 99th Executive Council session.

DR IYABODE MODUPE OLUSANMI

Southwest Nigeria Agent of Change Award



Dr Iyabode Olusanmi, formerly the UNICEF Representative in Ghana (2010–2013), is a highly motivated, very disciplined, results focussed, respectable and caring career woman, with about 49 years' work experience in public life, working with community leaders and the governments at Local Government, State, and National levels as well as the United Nations at International level. Her innate desire and commitment have always been to put smiles on the face of the less privileged.

Dr Olusanmi was born at Lagos into the family of Late Reverend August and Late Mrs Janet Olulade in Ake, Abeokuta, Ogun State, more than 70 years ago. She spent most of her early life in Ibadan, but has travelled far and wide, within the South Western States, to several states in Nigeria and to several countries in Africa, Asia, Europe and the Americas during the course of her work life, working with people with different cultures, religions and beliefs.

Iyabode Olusanmi is a graduate of the University of Ibadan (MB,BS 1976), with a post–graduate in Public Health (MSc Community Medicine) at the University of Edinburgh (1982). To these, she has added many additional training and laurels, including a Certificate in Planning, Research and Statistics at the University of Ilorin (1992), Certificate on Public Health in Complex Emergencies at the School of Columbia University in New York (1999) and Certificate in Project Management (University of Philippines, 2001)among others. She is a trainer in several areas of the health sector.

Dr Olusanmi had 14 years working experience with the Governments of Oyo and Osun States (1978–1992), starting as a Medical Officer grade 11, rising to the level of Deputy Director Primary Health Care and Chief Consultant Preventive in the then Oyo state(1991), and later became the foundation Director of Planning Research and Statistics in

Osun State (1991). Her exemplary work of leading Oyo State to set up functional systems, capacity building of staff and effective oversight in mother and child health and especially the Expanded Programme on Immunization (EPI), which helped Oyo State to achieve universal childhood immunization, caught the attention of UNICEF, which consequently requested for the services of Dr Olusanmi on loan to assist Edo and Delta states in improving their immunization coverage.

During Dr Iyabode Olusanmi's more than 20 years' experience in UNICEF (1992- 2013), she was the first Natonal PHC officer to be employed by UNICEF Nigeria (1992) and the first UNICEF National Zonal Programme Officer (1998), supervising the then 8 B Zone states. As the head of the UNICEF Ibadan Zonal Office, in addition to supervising professionals providing Water & Sanitation, Child Protection, Education, Nutrition support to the governments, she specifically advocated for and got the then Military Governors of the eight states to sign Memoranda of Understanding to fund mother and child health programmes in their different states. Her leadership and collaborative work with the governments in the region through the UNICEF supported Water and Sanitation and Health projects contributed significantly to the eradication of Guineaworm infections in the region.

Dr Olusanmi's duty tours outside the country, include: North Korea (1999–2002), where she was the only Nigerian working in the country apart from the Embassy staff and where she helped to revitalize their Immunization and Safe motherhood projects to contemporary standards, with the country subsequently getting grants from GAVI (Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunizations) and from other donors. In Kenya as Chief of Health (2002–2006), she notably, among other achievements, helped to revitalize the Safe Motherhood programme in Northern Kenya to reduce maternal mortality in the region.

In Sudan, as Deputy Representative and Representative a.i, (2006–2010), she led the mitigation of the crisis in the wartorn Darfur where about 4.7 million IDPs were being supported by UNICEF through technical assistance of about 100 staff and a \$280 million annual budget in both the North and Southern Sudan. In Ghana, she was commended for her exemplary leadership resulting in water availability in the most rural areas; out of school girls were encouraged and supported to go back to school and children were protected from abuse and being labelled and treated as

witches. She advocated with the government at the highest levels (President, Vice President, Ministers and Regional Governors), as well as donors and development partners to advocate for the rights of children and women. Postretirement, she was engaged pro bono by UNICEF, to be a mentor to newly appointed UNICEF Representatives (2014.

After the mandatory retirement from UNICEF in 2013, Dr Olusanmi as Chief of Party, successfully led the implementation of USAID funded (\$11million) Local Partners for Orphans and Vulnerable children, that was awarded to the Association for Reproductive and Family Health (2015–2020) and which touched the lives of 300,000 orphans and vulnerable children in 60,000 families in Lagos, Rivers and Akwa-Ibom states. The success of this project led to follow up USAID funded project (Integrated Child Health project, 2020–2024) to ARFH.

Dr Olusanmi's dedication, hard work and resilience earned her accolades at every stage of her working career and social life, including the Distinguished Achievement Award by the Nigerian Embassy in Ghana(2011), the award for Outstanding Service for Orphans and Vulnerable Children by Inner Wheel Nigeria (2019) and Outstanding Influencer Award by the Association for Orphans and Vulnerable Children in Nigeria (2019).

She is a member of several notable organizations, including the Medical and Dental Women's Association of Nigeria, Association of Public Health Physician of Nigeria, Fellow of the Institute of Management Consultants of Research of Nigeria, the Ibadan Recreation Club and a dedicated member of the Inner Wheel Nigeria, where she is currently the District Secretary for District 913, one of the 6 districts in Nigeria.

Iyabode Olusanmi is staunch Catholic and a strong member of the Catholic Women's Organization of Nigeria, a Jerusalem pilgrim (2005), the immediate Past Chairman of St Ignatius of Loyola Parish, Ibadan and a Board Member of the St Mary's Catholic Hospital at Eleta, a well renowned private hospital in Ibadan.

She was married to Late Dr Michael Olatunbosun Olusanmi, of Ipetu-Ijesha, Osun State and they are blessed with wonderful children and grandchildren.

PROF. BABATUNDE AJAYI OLOFINBIYI Southwest Nigeria Gold Award on Healthcare

Prof Babatunde Ajayi Olofinbiyi is a Professor of Obstetrics, Gynaecology and Adolescent Reproductive Health and a Public Health Physician at the College of Medicine, Ekiti State University and Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital, Ado-Ekiti, Nigeria, and presently the Chairman, University Ranking Committee of the Senate of Ekiti State University. He had a Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery degree at the University of Ilorin in year 2000. He holds Fellowship of West African College of Surgeons (FWACS); and Fellowship and Diploma Certificates in Minimal Access Surgery from World Laparoscopic Hospital Training Centre, New Delhi, India; and a Master of Science degree in Public Health from the University of South Wales, United Kingdom. At present, he is pursuing a PhD program in Community Medicine at Ekiti State University College of Postgraduate studies.

He was born at Iworoko-Ekiti in Ifelodun/Irepodun Local Government of Ekiti State on the 25th of May, 1969. He was the first medical officer to be sponsored by Ekiti State Government for in-service training to pursue a 5-year specialist course in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Obafemi Awolowo University Teaching Hospitals Complex, Ile-Ife in 2004. Prof. Olofinbiyi decided to pursue Obstetrics and Gynaecology as a line of specialty because he has always had strong passion for women-related reproductive issues and more so his fore-fathers and great fore-fathers were unmatchable and distinguished traditional birth attendants of their time. He was confirmed a Fellow of West African College of Surgeons in Obstetrics and Gynaecology in 2009.

He was sponsored again by Ekiti State Government to pursue a course in Minimal Access Surgery at the World Laparoscopic Hospital Training Center in New Delhi, India in 2010; this earned him a Fellowship and Diploma



in Minimal Access Surgery and a life member of World Laparoscopic Surgeons. He was employed as one of the pioneer lecturers in Obstetrics and Gynaecology Department of Ekiti State University College of Medicine in 2011.

He was sponsored again by Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital for a program on Diabetes in Pregnancy in San Francisco, United State of America in 2014; which conferred on him a honour of an Active Member of International Study Groups on Diabetes in Pregnancy.

He is a Honorary Consultant at the department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital, Ado- Ekiti and the first Residency Training Coordinator in the department who produced the first trained nine senior registrars and the department's first three specialists in Obstetrics and Gynaecology, during which the department recorded the highest pass rate in the history of postgraduate training programmes in the hospital. He was recently appointed as the Coordinator of the Nationwide World Health Organization (WHO)-Federal Ministry of Health Harmonized Maternal and Perinatal Database Project, Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital/Ekiti State Chapter, Nigeria. Dr Olofinbiyi Babatunde was the Acting Head of Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology of Ekiti State University College of Medicine between year 2020 and 2022; the department experienced the highest level of development and unprecedented feats in the departmental structure, service delivery, training and research in the two years of his stewardship. Dr Babatunde Olofinbiyi is a visiting Associate Professor to Afe Babalola College of Health Sciences and a Consultant to ABUAD Multisystem Hospital.

He was also the Chairman, Capacity Building Committee, Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital for 7 years, making him the longest serving chairman of the committee. He was also a member of Hospital Management Committee, Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital for 7 years and also the longest serving member of the committee in the history of the hospital. He is an active member of Federal Road Safety Corps, Ekiti State Chapter. Prof. Olofinbiyi is the Coordinating Consultant at Ekiti State Police Command

Hospital where he upgraded the status of the health facility from cottage clinic to tertiary hospital status within 5 years; during which he established highly functioning surgical, obstetric and gynaecological units which are now appreciably complementing the specialized medical and surgical services of the existing tertiary institutions in the State. Professor Olofinbiyi is a visionary mentor, gender advocate, and selfless guide; often described as a 'blind helper' for his unique support without bias or expectation. His impact spans the medical profession, social work, administration, and most notably academia, where he has nurtured the growth of at least 15 emerging scholars across various Nigerian universities. Remarkably, four of his mentees have risen to the rank of Senior Lecturer, while another four have attained the prestigious position of Professortestaments to his enduring legacy of academic excellence and leadership development!

Prof. Olofinbiyi is also the Provincial and Regional Director of Health and Medical services, Redeemed Christian Church of God, Nigeria, Ekiti Province 5 and Region 25 respectively; and also a parish Pastor in the Redeemed Christian Church of God (RCCG), Ekiti Province 5, Ado-Ekiti. Recently, he was appointed as the Director of Medical Services and Health, RCCG Region 25 Directorate of Youths and Young Adults Affairs. Dr Olofinbiyi is a visiting consultant and surgeon to the Redeemed Christian Church of God Hospital, Redemption City of God, Lagos; where he has been consistently coordinating the free health mission of the organization. He is also a member of Institute of Strategic Management, Nigeria. He is also the present Chairman, Parent-Teacher-Association of Fountain International High School, Ado-Ekiti, where he is currently coordinating the building and establishment of the first secondary school adolescent friendly clinic in Ekiti State. He is a consistent reviewer for many learned local and international journals. He has 130 publications in both local and international journals. Prof. Olofinbiyi was the first lecturer from Ekiti State University to be a member of Global Burden of Disease Research Hub based in Washington, USA.

He has had many awards of excellence for outstanding contributions to humanity and health. In the beginning of the year 2019, precisely March, a chapter, tagged "Tamed Champion" was written about Prof. Olofinbiyi Babatunde's personality in a book titled 'The Entrepreneur'; authored by the then Ekiti State Commissioner for Agriculture and Food

Security, a renowned business man and agriculturist of international repute - Prince Olabode Adetoyi. Prof. Olofinbiyi was the overall best resident of the year, awarded by Medical and Dental graduating students of Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife in 2010/2011. He was also the best graduating student, school of disciple, Ekiti State Province 1, Redeemed Christian Church of God, Ado-Ekiti in 2016. In 2016, Dr Olofinbiyi was given an award of the Friend of Association of Resident Doctors of Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital, Ado-Ekiti; and he happened to be the first consultant to get this type of award in the history of the teaching hospital. He would also be the first medical doctor to be a Patron to Students' Union Government of Ekiti State University Teaching Hospital School of Nursing, Ado-Ekiti. This year 2023, Dr Babatunde Ajayi Olofinbiyi was also given an Award of Meritorious Service to Humanity and Special Love for the Association of Nigeria Nurse Educators (ANNE) during their National Conference; he would be the first medical doctor and medical educator to get this type of special award in the history of organization.

He was awarded a honour of Southwestern Nigeria Outstanding Gynaecologist of the year by the highly reputable Southwest Nigeria Excellence Awards Organization at Obafemi Awolowo University Teaching Hospital Ile-Ife, on the 3rd of October, 2019. At the State Level, in 2022, Dr Olofinbiyi was the only medical lecturer given a privilege of contributing a chapter to a State book (first of its kind in the history of Ekiti State) published in honour of the first female head of service of Ekiti State, Mrs Peju Babafemi, titled, 'Adolescent reproductive health challenges: a striking area affecting the core values of future leaders', in Leadership, policy process, and governance in the Nigerian public service. Recently (2023), he was celebrated by the Management of Obafemi Awolowo University for winning the university's Best Manuscript Award of the Nigerian of Journal Health Sciences; for which the Ekiti State House of Assembly gave him acknowledgement and commendation. Recently, the Radio Nigeria honored Prof. Olofinbiyi with an award of outstanding gender advocate and philanthropist. More recently (2024), the founder of Afe Babalola University, a fore front Nigeria stateman, Aare Afe Babalola (SAN), celebrated and honored Dr Olofinbiyi on his well deserved monumental awards in various spheres of life; covering academics,

profession, religion, social work and other humanitarian services.

His main fields of interest are Adolescent Reproductive Health, Gynae oncology and Gynae endoscopy. Olofinbiyi Babatunde is one of the few Nigerians that are so passionate about adolescent sexual and reproductive health needs. He is doing a lot of work on adolescent reproductive health; especially in the areas of teenage pregnancy and girl-child education support. This has informed his founding a non-governmental organization tagged "Adolescent Friendly Research Initiative and Care". The NGO was rated as the best in Ekiti State by the Union Bank of Nigeria in 2019; other success stories recorded by the organization can be appreciated on the website of the organization.

Dr Olofinbiyi loves helping the needy and his ultimate goal is to make life better and more meaningful to the adolescents and every young person who are the bedrock of any nation. 




