Thank you for supporting the Sunset Hills Conservation Foundation. Our 501 (c)(3) organization was established in 2008, under the encouragement of former Mayor Bill Nolan. The organization's mission is to help preserve and enhance the city's natural beauty and enjoyment of green spaces and parks, enrich the arts of our city, preserve and honor our city's history, and provide enjoyable activities consistent with our overall mission.

Your contributions to the Sunset Hills Conservation Foundation have helped to open and upgrade Kitun Park and provide a grant to help build a children's fishing pond with a dock.

We have held events raising funds to upgrade Watson Trail Park's playground equipment for all children, including those with disabilities. This playground is only the second of its kind in the metropolitan area. Projects have included fishing derbies, signage, Earth Day saplings, a six month speakers series, and both the BIG deer at Laumeier and the "Peeps" sculpture that welcomes you to Watson Trail Park.

Each year we have sponsored the Maker's Market where 80+ local artists enter their art for show and sale. We sell ice cream at the Sunday Serenades and volunteer at the SunCrest Fest.

There are many other projects that we are planning, including adding more playground equipment for children with disabilities.

Annually, as you reflect on charitable giving, we ask you to consider our Foundation. Join a growing group of

people dedicated to enjoying green space, community amenities, and having fun. Membership levels are basic at \$100, sustaining for \$250, corporate for \$500 and a \$25 membership for students and citizens under 25. You do not have to be a resident of Sunset Hills, only someone who enjoys being active in our community.
