THE TUSCAN CHILD BY Rhys Bowen – 2/2018

Although slow starting the book turns into a pretty good mystery read. A WWII British bomber pilot parachutes into German-occupied Tuscany. Wounded, he hides in a ruined monastery and is surreptitiously aided by an Italian woman before he escapes and returns to live a full life in England. Thirty years later, after he dies, his estranged daughter finds in his effects an unopened letter addressed to the woman who helped him in Tuscany. The rest of story is what she finds out when she returns to understand her father's past in Tuscany based on the letter. She discovers the older townspeople seem to prefer not to talk about what they might know about her father and what turns out to be a surprising tangle of truths. Can't tell or will ruin for you ©

Tomato Pie

1 Red and 1 Yellow Tomato, sliced ¼" thick 8 oz. Mozzarella, sliced ¼" thick 9" Pie Crust

Put pie crust on parchment on cookie sheet. Arrange tomatoes alternating red and yellow with a cheese slice between each tomato slice.

Sprinkle with red pepper flakes, parsley, and basil – not too much of any.

Fold crust up over the edges. Brush the crust and tomatoes with olive oil. Sprinkle lightly with salt. I used Himalayan Pink Salt.

Bake at 375 degrees for 35 minutes. Let cool before slicing
