

MINI PUMPKIN PIE BITES

Prep Time: 10 Min Cook Time: 15 Min Total Time: 25 Min Yield: 48

Ingredients:

3/4 cup granulated sugar 2 large eggs

1 15 oz. can pumpkin 1 tsp ground cinnamon

½ tsp salt 1 12 oz. can evaporated milk

½ tsp ground ginger, 1/4 tsp grd .cloves 2 pre-made pie crusts

Cinnamon Whipped Cream: (this makes much more than you will need)

2 cups heavy whipping cream 1 tsp cinnamon ½ cup brown sugar 1 tsp vanilla

2 oz. cream cheese softened

Instructions:

- 1) Combine sugar, cinnamon, salt, ginger & clove in a small bowl
- 2) In separate bowl combine pumpkin and egg and beat with a mixer
- 3) Slowly combine dry ingredients with pumpkin mixture & mix well
- 4) Stir in evaporated milk gently
- 5) Unroll pie crusts & use a biscuit cutter to cut approx. 3" round circles
- 6) Place each circle in a greased mini cupcake pan to form small crusts
- 7) Fill each crust with a spoonful of pumpkin mixture just to top, don't mound
- 8) Bake at 400 for 12-15 minutes until mixture is set & and a toothpick comes out clean out of the middle.
- 9) Allow to cool completely before topping with the following whipped cream:
- 10) In a mixer or a bowl using a hand mixer beat cream cheese, then slowly add the heavy cream and beat until well mixed
- 11) Add in sugar, vanilla & cinnamon beat on high until stiff peaks form
- 12) Place into a pastry bag to pipe onto mini pumpkin pies
- 13) Sprinkle with cinnamon or brown sugar for added cuteness.
