#### ARTICHOKE PARMESAN BITES

PREP TIME: 5 MINS, COOK TIME: 15 MINS, TOTAL TIME: 20 MINS. INGREDIENTS:

- 3 (6-oz) jars marinated artichoke hearts, drained
- 3/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp garlic salt
- 4-oz cream cheese, softened
- 2 (15-count) packages mini phyllo shells

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

- 1. Place artichokes in food processor. Pulse 4 times, until artichokes are finely chopped. Add parmesan cheese, garlic salt and cream cheese. Pulse 2 or 3 times, until combined. Scoop into phyllo shells.
- 2. Bake for 15 to 20 minutes, until heated through.

# ARTICLE VI - ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE BOARD OFFICERS Every 2 years (biennial)

Section 1 - A ballot for nominating the slate of Executive Board officers must be presented to the full membership by way of the newsletter. Nominations should be approved beforehand by the member being nominated and returned to the Nomination Committee by the deadline given. Once the nominations are closed, an Election Ballot will be sent to the full membership for voting by email and/or mail.

Election of the Executive Board officers shall take place at prior to the January Luncheon Meeting. The Nominating Committee shall collect, and count ballots received at the luncheon in the Ballot Box, by mail or email and announce the results at the January Luncheon.
