



Kentucky Butter Cake

2 cups sugar

4 eggs

1 cup unsalted butter (2 sticks)

2 tsp. rum (or vanilla)

1 cup buttermilk

3 cups all-purpose flour

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. baking powder

1/2 tsp. baking soda

Sauce

3/4 cup sugar

1/3 cup unsalted butter

3 Tbsp. water

2 tsp. rum or vanilla

Combine dry ingredients, set aside. In a large bowl cream sugar, eggs, unsalted butter rum (or vanilla) and buttermilk. Add dry to the wet ingredients and mix until combined. Pour batter into a **well greased** bundt pan. Bake at 325 degrees for 55-60 minutes. Insert a toothpick to check for doneness. Cool in pan for at least 30 minutes. For the sauce combine all ingredients in a saucepan and cook over medium heat until fully melted. **Do not boil**. Pour over cake slowly, cake will soak up the sauce. Serves 10.
