Turn in Hooster Flags when entering.

Skipper of National Class Association Yachts are required to be Members in Good Standing of their respective class organizations.

Protests and other matters of controversy should be lodged with the Regatta Committee of the local club whose names will be posted at the entry desk. The association Regatta Committee acts only on appeals from local rulings.

Lightnings registered in the season championship series who fail to race sufficient number of races to qualify must withdraw from the championship fleet. However, a Lightning once registered in the season championship series may enter the individual race events only after it has taken two cuts in the championship fleet.

In the interest of good sportsmanship and better Lightning racing, the division of the Lightning Fleet has been arranged. Please do not enter the Season Championship Series of races, unless you are reasonably sure of racing in the required 7 races for qualification.

Lightnings racing in the Season Championship Series will be required to fly their Club Burgee on the back-stay, at least 2 feet above deck, in order to identify the two Fleets on racing days.

Any yacht withdrawing from a race without prompt notice to the Regatta Committee or to a patrol boat flying a numbered patrol flag, shall be disqualified for the season.

The BBYRA will send representative crews to compete for the Sears Bowl for Juniors under 17 and the Mrs. Charles Francis Adams Cup for Ladies. Mr. John C. Cattus of the Bay Head Yacht Club is Chairman of our Selection Committee and skippers interested in representing Barnegat Bay in these regattas should contact Mr. Cattus.

PRIZES

Pennants for first, second and third places each regatta and flags for season champion.

All Season Championship Trophies will be presented on the last race day on a basis of B.B.Y.R.A. points for the season. Second Place Trophies will be awarded to—Lightning, Comet, Jr. Comet, A. Sneak, B. Sneak, Snipe and C. Sloop. Third Place Trophies will be awarded to Lightning and Comet Classes.

George H. Powell Trophy (SPTC)—outstanding sportsmanship for Juniors.

The O. G. Dale Memorial Trophy (BBYRA) may again be awarded at the end of the season in recognition of outstanding sportsmanship.

The Chase Challenge Trophy (SPTC) will be awarded the 17-ft. Cat Champion.

Governor Rodman Trophy (BBYCA) for Class G Sloops will be presented on the last race day to the Class Champion.

The Reynolds Cup (BBYRA) will be awarded the Snipe Champion.
