


Lil Timme & 2'Live Bre Drop 'In the Trap' Video Amid Empire Signing Buzz

Released on MLK Day, performed live at Anzie Blue, and now gaining new momentum as 2'Live Bre inks a deal with Empire.

On January 17, 2025 — MLK Day — Lil Timme and 2'Live Bre released their collaborative single 'In the Trap.' The record symbolizes more than just trap energy; it represents unity, vision, and the grind of two Southern voices. Less than two weeks later, they brought the song to life on stage at Anzie Blue in Nashville with the Hynze Homie Band, during Timme's Pressure Vol. 2 – For the



Street release concert. The live performance proved the chemistry between the two artists was undeniable, igniting fans and showing the track's staying power. Since then, 2'Live Bre has signed with Empire, powered by the viral success of 'Southern Country Girl.' That momentum brings new light to 'In the Trap,' positioning it as both a testament to Timme's ability to align with talent early and as a key part of Bre's



catalog leading into his Empire journey. For Lil Timme, the collaboration threads seamlessly into his ongoing movement. Following the drop of 'Bag Chaser' in September 2025 and the upcoming single 'Joy' in December, all roads lead to Pressure Vol.
