Apparently over 120 cats were found in various stages of decomposition ranging from mere skeletons to.... The cats were found outside on the property and inside the unlivable home. At the time of the discovery, the woman involved was apparently living in her truck at the homesite off 29th Street in San Leon. The travesty was uncovered when a woman who had left her cat in good faith with the perpetrator to care for while she was traveling then returned to retrieve her cat and the woman entrusted with the cat said it had run away. The distraught cat owner began to investigate, which led to the discovery of what was taking place. bring more details as they are confirmed. 





San Leon Trash Updates

While there are still many Texas Pride trash containers remaining in San Leon, those appear to have been abandoned by the previous provider Texas Pride. Decker has been collecting the trash for a couple of weeks and will pick up trash from Texas Pride and other containers while the sudden transition is smoothing out. There has been a rate increase to \$23.75 a month under the new contract with a two month surcharge of \$2.00 to make up for the costs of the sudden change when Texas Pride abruptly decided to end their collections before their contract terminated on October 1. EPP will provide further information as it develops.
