

Who Doesn't Want A Great America?



Cool Whip Pudding Frosting

1 pkg. instant vanilla pudding mix (3.4 oz) 2 tbsp. powdered sugar 1/2 cup milk 1 tsp. vanilla extract 8 oz. container Cool Whip (thawed)



San Leon MUD Update

Hurricane Season

There have been a number of new folks moving to San Leon, so for those not in the know, hurricane season is here! Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1st and lasts until November 30th, with peak season from mid-August to late October. Galveston County Office of Emergency Management (GCOEM), has several resources available on its website, www.gcoem.org, including preparation guides for adults and kids, as well as links to sign up for the State of Texas Emergency Assistance Registry, a free registry that provides local emergency planners and emergency responders with additional information on the needs in the community.

Brush Bundling & Debris Removal

With hurricane season here, be sure to clean up your property, removing any debris that may block drainage or become projectiles in the event of high winds. While Galveston County is not responsible for picking up brush or debris, Texas Pride will pick up brush that's placed in clear, individual piles measuring no larger than 3' x 3' x 3' or tied and bundled and under 50 pounds.






A Study In Cooperation

Recently, on a Friday night around 8:00 pm, the San Leon VFD got called out for a structure fire in the community. They responded within minutes and arrived at the scene very quickly and sprung into action to address the situation. Very quickly, Bacliff VFD was enroute to the scene to support their neighboring community Upon arrival with their first volunteers. engine, they provided water from their tank to supplement the water San Leon was using from their pumper. Upon arrival of Bacliff's second pumper, they immediately connected around 500 feet of 5 inch hose to a hydrant to provide a continuous water supply to the San Leon Firefighters who were engaged at the fire

The well trained San Leon volunteers quickly resolved the situation with minimal damage to the affected property. Taking the time to search for potential hotspots, they ensured that the fire was out and there was no further risk to people or property. Both departments regularly support each other and often train together. The spirit of teamwork and cooperation is evidence at what could have been a tragic scene is a tribute to the members of both departments that invest their time and risk their personal safety to support their communities. EPP feels compelled to spread the good word as it relates to good people doing good work. If you can't become a volunteer yourself, take a moment to appreciate those that can and do.

Hurricane Tips From Galveston County CERT

Please take the time to review your plans in case a storm is heading our way.

Do you have flood insurance? Do you have all your insurance information readily available to you either in a water-proof box or saved on a cloud so that you can access from anywhere you have access to the internet? Do you have your health insurance and doctor's information available, even if you evacuate for a storm? Do you have at least 10 days' worth of yours or a family member's prescriptions?

Do you have vaccine records and health records for pets? Do you have prescriptions for your pets that you can take with you if needed? Do you have food, crate, or other items that your pet may need if you must evacuate?

Do you have storm supplies such as a radio, batteries, flashlights, water, food that can be prepared and eaten without power, plans to charge electronic devices, and other needs that affect your ability to wait out power being re-established?

Also, please take time to talk to your neighbors and others who may be new to the area and let them know how to prepare for a safe Hurricane Season!

EPP recommends that readers get familiar with gcoem.org for further information and that all who are able take the free CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) training when it is offered. The family you protect with that training may well be your own.
