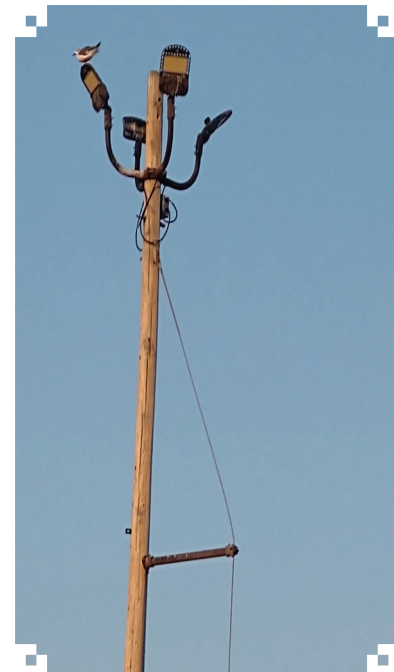

She Got This Done

EPP has been regularly and justifiably critical of Julie Diaz who runs the Galveston County Parks Department. As EPP strives for fairness and accuracy in its reporting, it is appropriate for a success to be reported among the many failures that have been brought to light. The pier shown is in Bacliff across from Noah's Ark on Boulevard. The pier was badly damaged during Beryl and it was fundamentally unsafe for the public that did continue to utilize it. In only about a month, repairs have been made. For the parks department, this is somewhat like having lightning hit a pre-arranged target on demand, but it is a success nonetheless and is being reported as such.

The other photo is of the parking lot light at Spillway Park and for some unknown reason, it seems that it is impossible to get two of the four bulbs replaced and has been apparently impossible for many months. The community is not asking for the many security and area lights that were paid for by the taxpayers and once nicely illuminated the park something like the way Carbide Park is lit now, but have been allowed to fall into disrepair. Rather, fixing the one pole with four light fixtures of which only two currently function is apparently asking for that same pre-arranged lightning to strike twice to benefit the public. EPP always provides contact information for the parks director/destroyer and this issue is no exception. Let her know that the pier repair is appreciated but ignoring Spillway Park is not only not appreciated, but is just flat wrong.

Publisher's Note: As of just before press time, EPP has learned that Spillway Park is completely dark at night with zero working lights and has been that way for days. But, the grass is mowed, so the citizens know where park priorities lie.

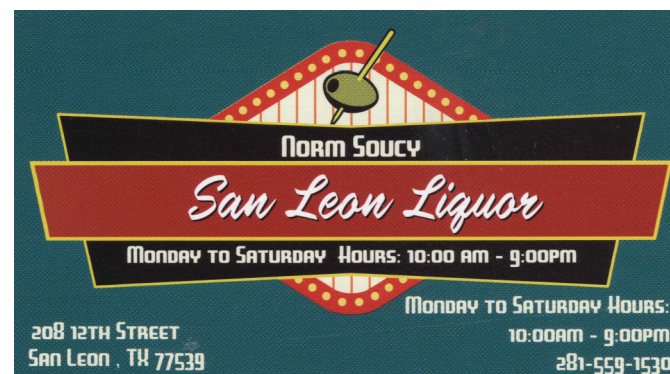

Restaurant Review

EPP had the opportunity to stop by James Coney Island in Webster on a recent Saturday. The visit, simply stated, was disappointing. Arriving at 10:31 with opening time clearly marked as 10:30 the door was approached and found to be locked. A car that had been idling nearby noted that and left the parking area. A couple minutes of delay was not the end of the world, but when the manager came to unlock the door, that is exactly what he did and not one thing more. He did not push the door open, say "sorry for the delay" or "welcome to James Coney Island", he simply unlocked the door and walked away to arrive at the cash register where he again failed to offer the simplest of greetings. The conversation was then limited to "you want everything on those?" when the order for the Tommy's Triple was placed. The price was announced and after payment the receipt was handed over in silence.

In a few minutes the order number was called and the order was retrieved. Returning to the table, the order was correct in that it had fries and three "all the way" coneys on the tray. The fries were hot, but not crispy. The hot dog buns were firm and not steamed warm and soft as expected and the hot dogs were lukewarm. Not the worst lunch ever, but so far below the expected quality that it was not surprising that in 37 minutes not a single other customer entered the establishment.

Getting back to the manager, he did emerge into the dining room and spoke on his cell phone for at least ten minutes, neither paying attention to, much less asking "how is your meal?" before or after his phone call. EPP has been eating at James Coney Island for decades, beginning with the long gone but still remembered franchise location in Clear Lake City on Bay Area Boulevard, which was the best location when compared to a number of other, all corporate stores, that have been visited over the years. Will JCI get another chance? With EPP's eternal optimism, probably so, but perhaps this review will make its way to corporate headquarters and someone there will reach out and correct these issues before another location has to close.

Sweet Tea-Peach Low Country Pork Ribs

3 lbs. boneless country-style pork ribs
 3 fresh peaches, peeled, pitted, and sliced
 1 sweet onion, thinly sliced
 1 lemon, halved and seeded
 1 cup sweet tea
 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
 1/8 teaspoon ground cloves
 4 1/2 cups hot cooked rice pilaf
 1/4 cup toasted pecans

Place all ingredients, except rice and pecans, in a 5 qt. slow cooker. Stir to coat. Cover and cook on low for 7 to 9 hours.

In a bowl, stir together rice and pecans. Drizzle with juices from slow cooker and serve alongside pork.

Makes 6 servings.

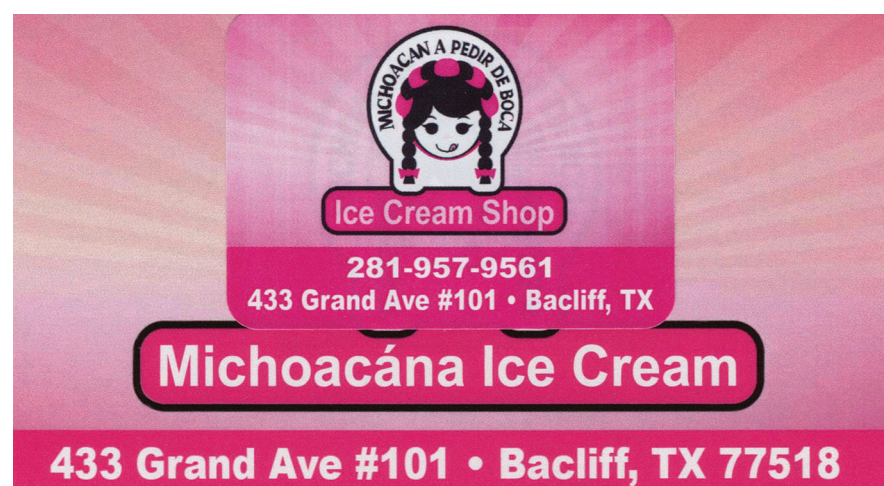

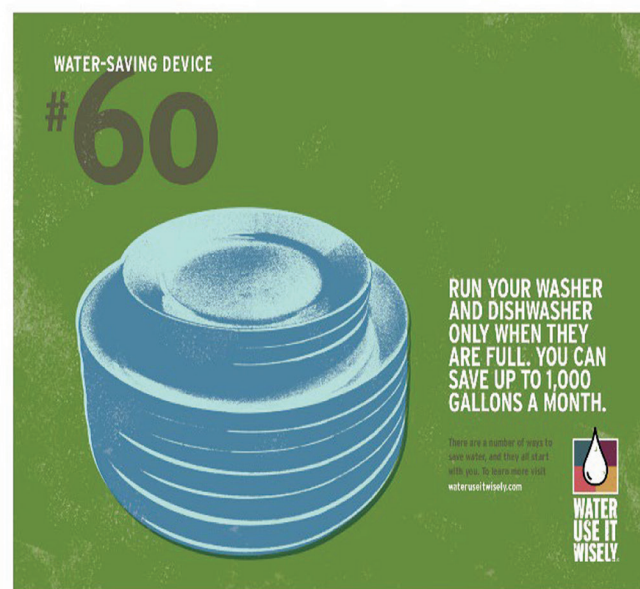
