Work that requires skill and labor in the field has long been safe from overseas labor.

The anticipated new economy will bring back skilled labor that happens in a factory, a plant or on a farm or ranch. As the illegal immigrant population diminishes, the downward pressure on wages will be reduced and those whose skills, hard work and dedication demonstrate their merit will be able to work and live comfortable, fulfilling lives. It is time for young people to stop being told that college and its often associated enormous debt is the only answer. Learning vocations/trades and essential math, reading and science will be a reliable path to success.

Fathers need to return to teaching their sons about tools and problem solving and mothers need to do the same for their daughters. EPP encourages a broad variety of skills to be handed to the next generation before the current generation takes that knowledge to their graves.

The second CERT Academy of 2025 will take place at the Bayside Regional Park Community Center located at 4833 10th Street, Bacliff, TX 77518.

This training is completely free of cost! The training dates and times are as follows:

May 2 (Friday) 6:30 pm to 10 pm

May 3 (Saturday) 8:30 am to 5:00 pm

May 4 (Sunday) 1 pm to 5:00 pm

May 9 (Friday) 6:30 pm to 10 pm

May 10 (Saturday) 8:30 am to 5:00 pm

You need to attend all the class session and times to complete the academy. Some missed time can be made up by turning in an outline of the material missed in class, but you cannot make up the work on Saturday, May 10th in the afternoon. If you have to miss the class and drill on the 10th, it can only be made up with another CERT Academy in the near future.

All materials will be provided for you, and you will receive emergency supplies and personal protective equipment.

You are welcome to bring snacks and drinks to class with you.

Minors, 13 and older, are welcome, but must be accompanied by an adult or parent, unless the student possesses a valid Texas Driver's license.

Cinnamon Bubble Bread

Melted butter
Cinnamon sugar

Prepare yeast dough from your favorite roll or bread recipe. Great a tube pan. Pinch the dough off in balls, about an inch in diameter. Roll balls in melted butter and a mixture of cinnamon and sugar. Place the balls in a hot and miss fashion in the pan until the pan is half full. Allow the bread to rise and bake at 375 degrees until done. To serve, invert on a plate and let each person break off bubbles.

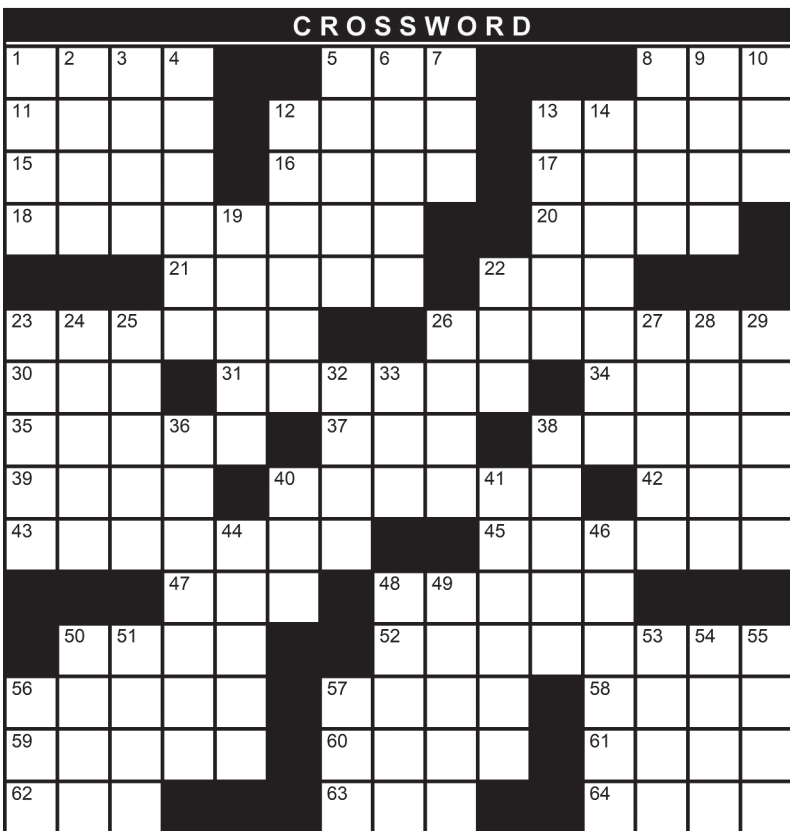

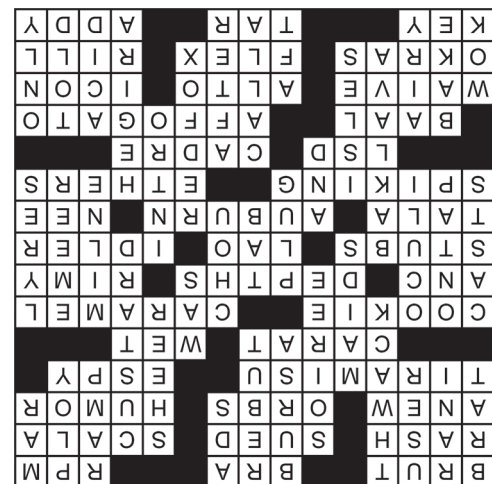

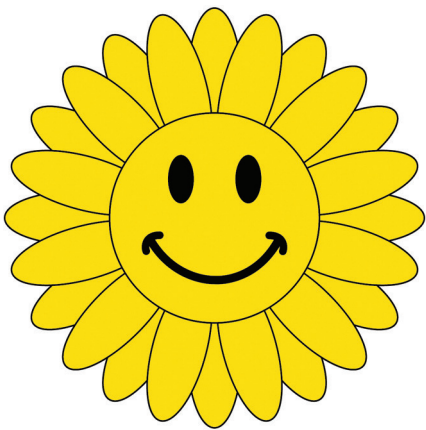

Restaurant Review

Pepe's on Fairmont in LaPorte was once called Las Hadas. The name changed a few years ago, but the food is the same. The real claim to fame is the fantastic salsa verde. It is not spicy and not guacamole based, but is loaded with onion and fantastic flavor. It is reason enough to go there. Their taco al carbon is more like a burrito, stuffed with diced beef or perhaps chicken and served with rice, beans, pico de gallo and guacamole. That one "taco" along with the inevitable gorging on the delicious green sauce will definitely fill up most diners. You do have to request the salsa verde or you will just get the fairly standard red sauce with your chips, which are thin but strong. EPP has been eating at this location under both names for years when in the area and it never fails to satisfy. Expect a tab of around \$20 per person for lunch.

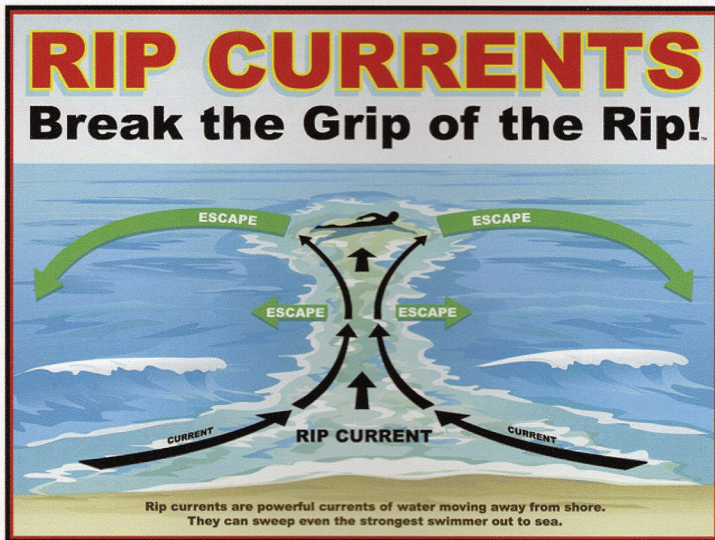

Finally, I want to ask you to mark Saturday June 28 on your calendars. That is the date of our Lincoln Reagan dinner. Details will be forthcoming very soon
