Salt and Pepper
Flour

Prepare squash and eggplant by slicing them very thin and soaking the slices in cold salted water. Drain well on paper towel. You may shake vegetables in flour and salt and pepper, or cornmeal, or pancake mix. Coat well. The okra needs no soaking. Cut in small pieces and fry all in hot grease as you would chicken. Fry until golden brown and drain. Serve immediately.



San Leon MUD Update



Property Address Reminder

Part of San Leon's rate order requires that all residential and commercial buildings in the district have the property address posted on the building. The letters and numbers used to mark addresses should be at least three inches high and should be placed on the building so they are visible from the street. This is to the residents' benefit as well since any EMS responders will be better able to locate your property with the address visible.

Galveston County Mosquito Control

Galveston County has a fleet of vehicles that are deployed throughout the county to spray for mosquitos. If you have any questions regarding spraying schedule or want to request spraying in your area, you can call them at 800.842.5622 or visit their website to see maps of the locations they've recently sprayed as well as where they intend to spray next.

Brush Bundling & Debris Removal

With hurricane season here, be sure to clean up your property, removing any debris that may block drainage or become projectiles in the event of high winds. While Galveston County is not responsible for picking up brush or debris, Texas Pride will pick up brush that's placed in clear, individual piles measuring no larger than 3' x 3' x 3' or tied and bundled and under 50 pounds.



BURN BAN IN EFFECT

There Is A Burn Ban

In effect in Galveston County. It will likely be lifted or expire soon based on the rains that have occurred after it was enacted. A burn ban does not mean that every outdoor fire is banned. Take the trouble to look up the laws yourself, but EPP understands that recreational fires, cooking fires and heating fires are still permitted. That said, safe burning is always the right way to burn. Consider the surroundings, the wind and have a source of water (garden hose, etc.) to contain and extinguish that fire as necessary. And please don't drag the firemen out of their lives and their homes because the neighbor you hate is roasting marshmallows over the firepit on the patio.
