- There will be no private meetings, no sponsor/sponsee meeting at this time.

Room Guidelines:

- Main Room holds: 10 people
- Al-anon Room holds: 7 people
- Main room will be used for ALL meetings, Al-anon & Eirst-steps room will be used as overflow rooms.
- These requirements will remain in place until removed or altered by the Coon Rapids Alano Board.

Cleaning Guidelines

Proper cleaning of chairs and hard surfaces

- Before meeting spray chairs and all hard surfaces (including handles and doorknobs) with SIMPLE GREEN D. Let remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe off with paper towel.
- After meeting, wash all chairs and hard surfaces (including handles and doorknobs) with hot soapy water.
- Spray chairs and all hard (including handles and doorknobs) surfaces with SIMPLE GREEN D and let air dry.
