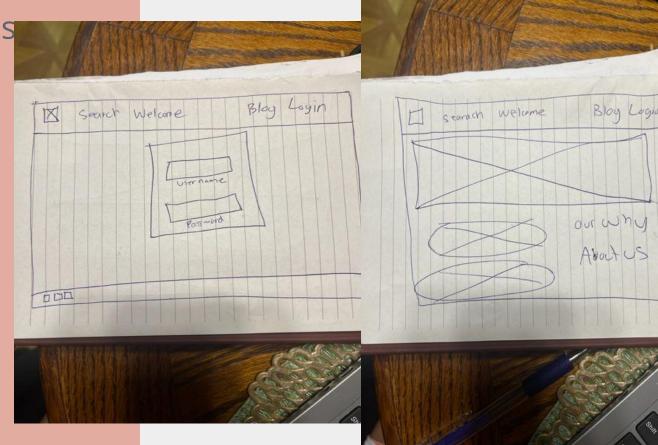
 Spends countless hours on social media looking for women that looks like her.

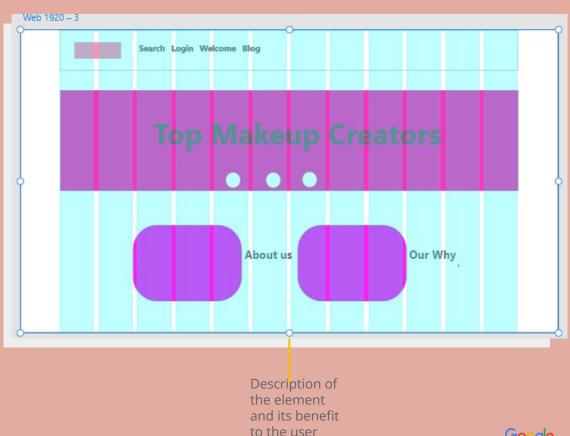

Digital wireframes

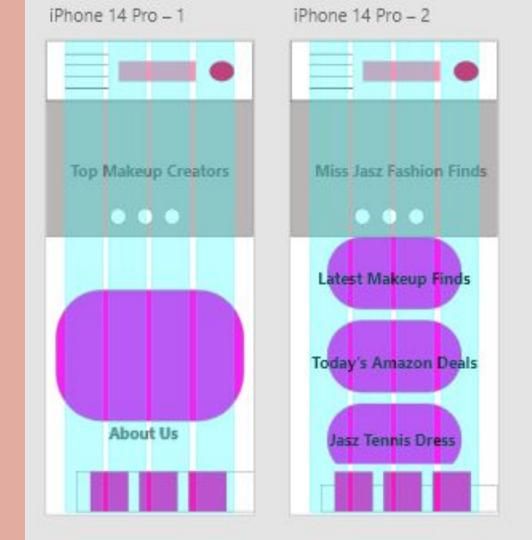
The home screen pictures were to include carousel pictures. Users feel like the focus should be on the overall goal of the website.





Digital wireframe screen size variation(s)

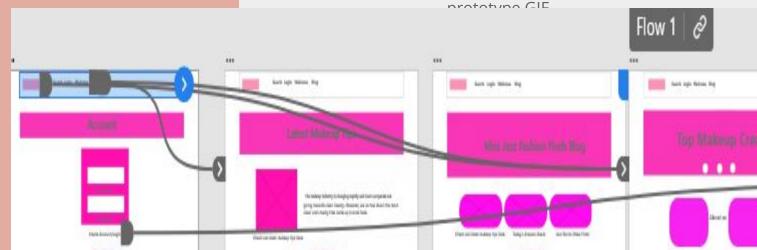
Users wanted less creation of the website with carousel images and to focus on overall purpose. The overall purpose is to bring tips to beginners in makeup without scrolling through social media constantly.

Users expressed gratitude for website being aimed towards beginners in makeup.

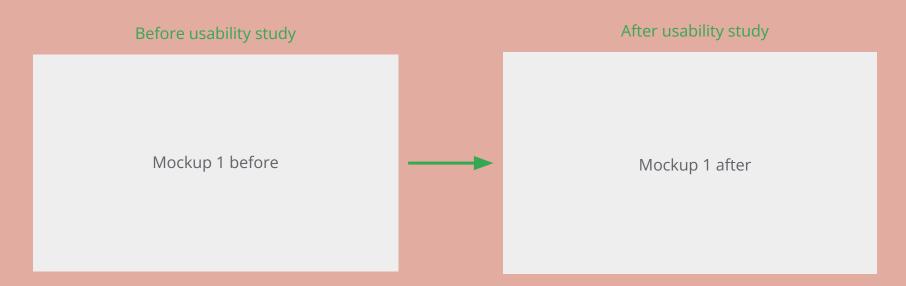

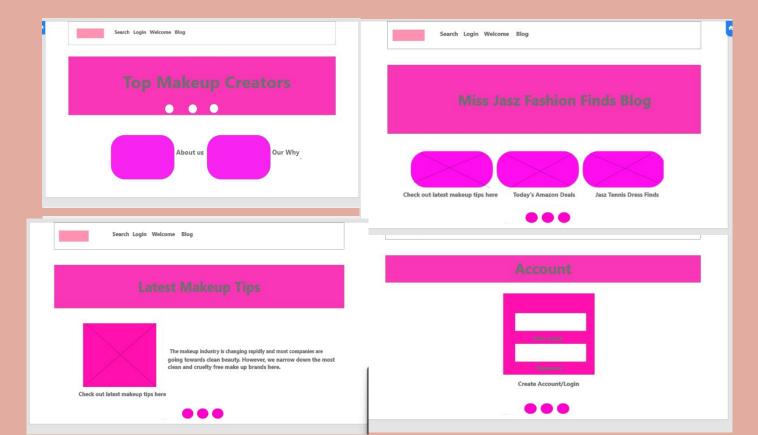

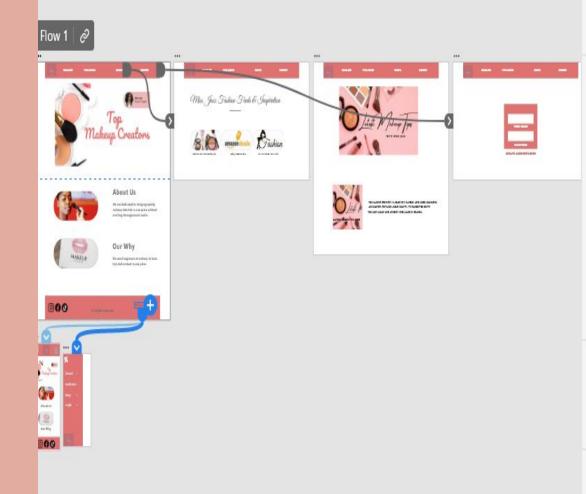
