12-Month Wedding Planning Timeline

12+ Months Before

- Celebrate your engagement!

- Create a guest list draft
- Choose your wedding party
- Research and visit potential venues
- Select your wedding date
- Book your venue(s)
- Research photographers, videographers, and other key vendors



9-12 Months Before

- Book your photographer and videographer
- Research and book caterer
- Shop for wedding dress and accessories
- Create wedding website
- Send save-the-dates
- Book entertainment (band, DJ)
- Reserve accommodations for out-of-town guests
- Meet with officiants and plan ceremony

6-9 Months Before

- Choose bridesmaids' dresses
- Register for gifts
- Book florist
- Book transportation
- Order invitations and other stationery
- Plan rehearsal dinner
- Schedule hair and makeup trials
- Book honeymoon accommodations

4-6 Months Before

Choose groom's and groomsmen's attire

- Purchase wedding rings
- Schedule dress fittings
- Finalize menu and cake
- Book rehearsal dinner venue
- Plan welcome bags for out-of-town guests

2-3 Months Before

- Send wedding invitations
- Create wedding day timeline
- Purchase gifts for wedding party
- Finalize ceremony details
- Apply for marriage license
- Confirm details with all vendors
- Finalize reception seating plan

1 Month Before

- Final dress fitting
- Create shot list for photographer
- Confirm RSVPs and finalize guest count
- Confirm honeymoon details
- Break in wedding shoes
- Prepare wedding vows
- Arrange final vendor payments

1 Week Before

- Get mani/pedi and other beauty treatments
 Pack for wedding night and honeymoon
 Confirm all transportation arrangements
 Prepare final payments and tips for vendors
- Drop off welcome bags at hotels
- Attend rehearsal and rehearsal dinner

Wedding Day

- Eat breakfast
- Give wedding rings to best man/maid of honor
- Allow plenty of time for hair and makeup
- Relax and enjoy your special day!

Working with Your Photographer

Before the Wedding

- Schedule an engagement session to get comfortable in front of the camera
- Create a shot list of must-have photos
- Discuss locations, lighting preferences, and photography style
- Share any specific concerns or insecurities
- Provide family grouping lists for formal portraits

Wedding Day Photography Timeline

- Getting Ready: 2 hours before ceremony
- First Look: 30 minutes (if applicable)
- Wedding Party Photos: 1 hour
- Family Portraits: 30 minutes
- Couple Portraits: 30-45 minutes (split between pre-ceremony and sunset)
- Reception Details: 15 minutes (before guests enter)
- Reception Coverage: Include first dance, toasts, cake cutting, and at least 1 hour of dancing



Photo Communication Tips

- Designate a photo-savvy family member to help gather people for group shots
- Let your photographer know about any family dynamics to be aware of

- Discuss any sensitive topics (family estrangements, body insecurities)
- Share your favorite features you'd like highlighted
- Communicate any must-have shots that aren't obvious

Beauty Essentials

- Makeup for touch-ups
- Lipstick/gloss
- Blotting papers
- Hairspray
- Bobby pins
- Hairbrush/comb
- Deodorant
- Perfume
- Breath mints

Clothing Fixes

- Fashion tape
- Safety pins
- Sewing kit
- Stain remover pen
- Lint roller
- Static guard
- Extra earring backs
- Clear nail polish (for stocking runs)

Health & Comfort

- Pain reliever
- Antacids
- Bandages
- Tissues
- Eye drops
- Allergy medication
- Tampons/pads
- Contact lens solution
- Blister pads
- Comfortable shoes for reception

Miscellaneous

- Phone charger
- Cash for tips
- Wedding timeline
- Vendor contact information
- Snacks
- Water bottle
- Straws (to drink without ruining lipstick)

Posing Tips for Beautiful Photos

General Posing Tips

- Practice good posture
- Create space between your arms and torso
- Angle your body slightly instead of facing the camera straight-on
- Chin slightly forward and down
- Relax your hands and fingers
- Take deep breaths before important shots

Standing Poses

- Put weight on back foot Bend front knee
- slightly Create a subtle S-curve with
- your body
- Hand placement: lightly on hip, holding bouquet, or gently touching dress

Sitting Poses

- Sit at the edge of chair or surface
- Cross ankles or legs at angle
- Sit tall through torso
- Arrange dress carefully for shape and detail

With Your Partner

- Connect through touch
- Create different heights (sitting/standing combinations)
- Walking shots: walk slowly and naturally
- Whispering moment: have partner whisper something genuine to create natural laughter

Candid Moments

- Be present and emotional
- Don't avoid tears they make beautiful photos
- Interact naturally with loved ones
- Remember to pause and take mental photographs throughout your day
