<u>Situation:</u> The Anne Arundel Young Marines are conducting a unit encampment for all participating Young Marines and Adult Volunteers to train together, Learn needed field skills, Develop a sense of camaraderie with the unit, and have fun.

<u>Mission:</u> To conduct a successful escapement to include PT, DDR, PO sign offs, community service, and outdoor activities.

- Location: Sandy Point Park 1100 E College Pkwy, Annapolis, MD 21409
- Arrival:
  - Adult Volunteer Arrival: Friday, between 5 pm 5:30 pm
  - Young Marine Arrival: Friday, at 6:30 pm, no later than 8 pm.
- Departure: All Sunday at 11am.
- Attire:
  - Friday/Check In: BDU with white t-shirt, NO ribbons.
  - Saturday: PT uniform, black shorts, tennis shoes.
  - Sunday: Green unit t-shirt, black shorts, tennis shoes.

ALL: Bring sweatshirt! Weather is unpredictable this time of year

• Facilities: Young Marines and Adult Volunteers will billet in tents. \*Male and females will be posted in separate areas unless part of a family unit

#### **Anne Arundel Young Marines**

Action: The following information includes details for Staff and attendees.

- Registration: To complete registration for each attendee, the following forms are required:
  - Hold Harmless Agreement
  - Authorization for medical treatment

Completed forms are sent to the Unit XO at <a href="mikemager07@gmail.com">mikemager07@gmail.com</a> by September 8th, 2025. Forms shall be emailed to families along with this document. Once sent, Michael Mager, or another Adult Volunteer, will confirm receipt.

- Medical: Ensure all medical paperwork is completed thoroughly and accurately. The Activity Medical Officer (AMO) will collect medication upon arrival during check-in. Medication must be in the original prescription or over the counter container with instructions on frequency and dosage. Young Marines with doctor's notes and/or injuries will report to the AMO during check-in. In case of injury or incident during the event, the following medical facilities will be utilized:

- Responsibilities: This section lists responsibilities for individuals attending the event.
  - Commander:
    - o Oversee encampment to ensure successful execution
  - Executive Officer:
    - o Collect and maintain paperwork for the event
    - o Keep all paperwork on hand throughout the event
    - o Coordinate activities
    - o Coordinate supervision for activities
    - o Ensure equipment needed for activities is on hand
    - o Ensure requirements are met for awards/ribbons
  - Adjutant:
    - o Keep detailed record of achievements
    - o Work with the Young Marines to prepare food
  - Activity Medical Officers (AMO) / This escapement: Brian Ott, and Dana DeLucca:
    - o Collect and maintain all medications during check-in for Young Marines in attendance
    - o Collect any additional medical documents from Young Marines during check-in
    - o Distribute medications when necessary and maintain medical logs

#### Anne Arundel Young Marines

- o Maintain medical office throughout the event and be available during activities in case of incident or injury
- o Keep all required forms on hand in case of incident or injury
- Unit Senior Young Marines:
  - o Conduct formations
  - o Coordinate platoons for chow
  - o Ensure Staff is always informed
  - o Assign duties to Young Marines of lesser rank for smooth execution of all evolutions
  - o Assist Unit Commander and Staff


