Thet SCCSA is composed of 20 Clubs located from Caloundra to Noosa and west to Nambour and the Range, and from this year Eumundi. It's composed of over 3,500 junior members and holds a strong reputation to be a family and community orientated group.

#### Key Information

- <u>Age Groups</u>
  - Anyone who was born in the years 2011 to 2017 (inclusive)
  - All players that have been registered at our indoor-Saturday mornings, and are of the ages required, we will give them the option to play outdoor or continue learning on Saturdays.
- <u>Training Days</u>
  - After school one training a week
    - 3pm to 4.15pm at the Eumundi State School Oval on Tuesday or Wednesday
    - 4pm to 5.15pm at the Eumundi Showgrounds on Monday or Wednesday
    - Once we get teams sorted, we will announce who goes where however, we'll be aiming for younger players to play at School and older ones at the Showground.
    - Once all teams are sorted, we shall announce when training commences.
      - We are aiming at the week of the 19<sup>th</sup> of February
- Game Days
  - Saturday mornings, played anywhere in the Sunshine Coast from Noosa to Caloundra and west to Nambour.
  - Competition commences on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> of March
  - Fixture and Calendars will be provided once they are announced.



- <u>Teams</u>
  - We will endeavour to have teams for everyone that registers, this will depend on number of players to be able to register them.
    - 2016 to 2017: 6 + 3 reserves
    - 2014 to 2015: 9 + 3 reserves
    - 2011 to 2012: 11 + 5 reserves
  - The Coach shall decide the composition of each team and will inform everyone, once these are complete.
  - Depending on numbers, some teams might be combined.
  - All teams must have a parent volunteering to look after the team as a Team Leader, who shall accompany the team to all games and make sure that all players have fair time on the field.
  - We shall endeavour to get teams for all interested players however, if we do not get enough numbers, we shall either allocate them, if possible, in other Magpies' teams or unfortunately, we will not be able to register them.
- <u>Kits</u>
  - The Club shall facilitate the shirt to all registered players, which is included in the Registration fee
  - All players require black shorts and black long socks
    - Existing players can use their current shorts and socks
    - Otherwise, the Club will be selling these
      - Price to be confirmed and facilitated before the competition starts
  - It is compulsory for all players to play with proper soccer boots and shin pads.



- <u>Registration Fees</u>
  - The fees for this season are (insurance is covered):
    - \$260 for anyone born in 2015, 2016 and 2017.
    - \$290 for anyone born in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014.
  - Fees must be paid directly to the Club this year however, from next year all payments shall be through the Association.
    - Please follow our Registration Process (see below)

  - CLOSE ON SATURDAY 3 FEBRUARY
  - To Register your player please visit <u>https://eumundimagpies.org.au/registration</u> and follow the prompts.
  - From Saturday 27 January through to Saturday 3 February
    - Ideally online or in-person at the school hall from 12 (after training)
    - Unfortunately, we will not be able to be within their payment system, so we will have to proceed with our current payment system, through bank deposits.
