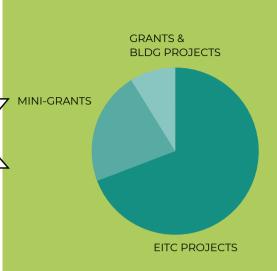
Every dollar donated, every hour volunteered, and every ounce of support we receive plays a pivotal role in shaping the lives of countless young minds.

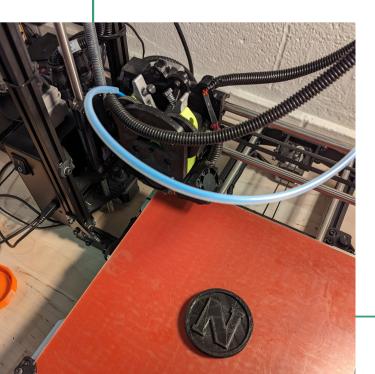


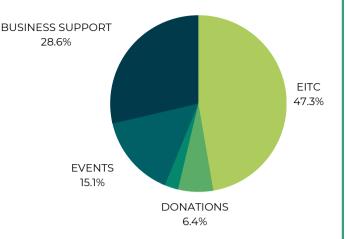


INCOME SOURCES

- EITC 6 outstanding community partners contributed 47% of our income through the PA EITC program.
- ANNUAL PARTNERS -Tremendous support by local businesses. This income source grew 25% Y/Y.
