 - Taking a stance of not holding an event is taking a stance.
 - When is this hindering the mission of the foundation? Or do we try to recognize what is best for the foundation?
 - Are we politically neutral by holding an event there?
 - Virtual vote will be sent out to make a decision about putting a deposit down for next year.

- O Donor event: Very successful event; Amy followed up with everyone during and after the event.
 - Date will be moved to a Tuesday next year to avoid conflict with school board meetings.
 - Short PowerPoint presentation helped people understand more of what the foundation does.
 - Having a teacher or student speak would be a helpful addition.
 - Valerie will share the annual report for board members to send out.
- o Goal Tracking Update -board members are encouraged to <u>visit Bloomerang</u>.
 - Metric Tracking for Interactions
 - Annual sponsorships: Goal is \$50,000, Current is \$7,583 or 15% of our goal; verbal commitments are at \$23,000, which is 46% of our goal.
 - Event fundraising goal is \$38,390, currently at \$22,847 or 60% of our goal.
 - General donations currently \$7,323 (44% of our goal)
 - Restricted donations \$140,000; currently at \$110,000 (70% of goal)
 - At 60% of our overall goal for the year
 - New partners: Bob Cauley & Opus Financial Partners, Community Bank as Bronze sponsorship, Working on NFI Warehouse, Country Doctor upgraded their sponsorship after donor event
 - Amy needs contacts at the warehouses or Jaindl- please share with her any names you know.
