- New Business
 - NWLSD Budget Presentation
 - Christie Steigerwalt shared an overview of the budget
 - Gov. Shapiro's budget proposal and what that would mean for NWLSD if it would get approved.
 - NWLSD is always "more wealthy" than the average in Lehigh County; weighted average daily membership- how we are paid in Basic Education Formula
 - Raised taxes to the max for the last five years; all went to staff salaries
 - How do you continue to be competitive as a district?
 - \$3.6 million deficit; looking at revenue generation
 - How can NWLEF help?
 - NWLEF funds anything that cannot be covered by school budget (i.e. chromebooks, smart boards)
 - Partner with District on the PR side to educate people about what the foundation does and the programs/ things we fund.
 - Some ideas:
 - Grant to fund a social worker at the high school to help with academic needs, attendance, etc. (grant ½; district ½)
 - Therapy/ Facility dog
 - Bus wrap for revenue
 - o Purchase The Night before Kindergarten books for kindergarten registration.

• Report of the Treasurer

- o No bills for payment
- Current reporting period: Feb and March
 Total income for this period: \$19,339.30
 Total expenses for this period: \$7,439.86
- Allocations: \$124, 610Balance: \$40, 107.93
- o Concern about low balance in account; goal is 65,000, but we are currently at \$40,000.
- o EITC funding is slightly above the 80% requirement needed to use EITC funding
- Finance committee needs to find a budget number before they give allocations committee a number. So
 we do not put the foundation at an at-risk position.
