

#### DRESS CODE FOR LODGE HOME

- A. Acceptable items of clothing:
  - Shorts of proper length
  - Bermuda shorts and split skirts
  - 3. Sport shirts, knit shirts and T-shirts (clean without offensive logos, etc.)
  - 4. Dresses, suits, skirts, slacks and sport coats
  - 5. Jeans may be worn as long as they are clean and not torn, frayed, cut, etc.
  - Shoes must be worn at all times
  - Women's sleeveless tops may be worn as long as they are appropriate.
  - Sun dresses may be worn as long as appropriate.
- B. Unacceptable items of clothing:
  - 1. You may not wear muscle shirts

  - Short shorts
  - Halters or tube tops

Note: Dress Code for special occasions as adopted by the Executive Board will be posted in lodge home or printed in monthly newsletter.

Discretion and final decision will be made by the bar stewardess.

Any member violating these rules may be asked to leave the premises and denied social privileges until reinstated by the Executive Board. Any member charged with violations of these rules and regulations shall be entitled to a hearing before the Executive Board.
