2024 Cash Raffle

By entering this charity raffle, you are stating that you have read the raffle rules and understand them. Notre Dame Catholic School thanks you for your support of this wonderful cause!

1. Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of entry and a legal resident of the United States to be eligible.
2. Grand Prize Winner will receive a \$10,000.00 cash prize. The second place winner will receive a \$5,000.00 cash prize and the third place winner will receive a \$1,000.00 cash prize. A minimum of 300 tickets must be sold for the winners to take the cash prizes offered. If 300 tickets are not sold, a 60/40 raffle will be held.
