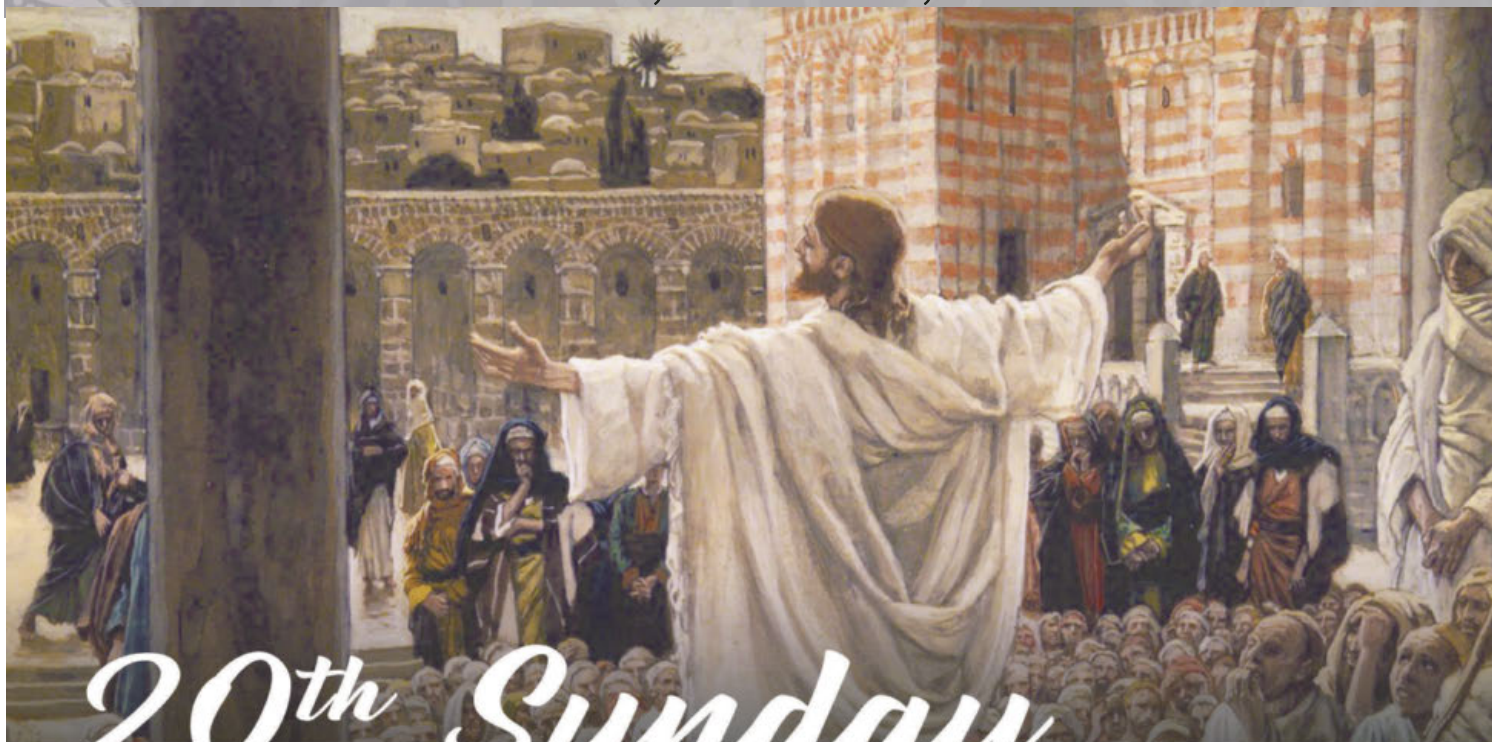

August 17, 2025

The way we sometimes behave in family and with friends is painful: arguments, revenge, senseless arguments, just to hurt each other. We argue over politics, sports, religion, and more. We flare up out of nowhere; it seems like we're bringing fire to argue. We lose control out of nowhere and for no reason. But the fire Jesus speaks to us about today is different. It is the fire of justice, forgiveness, and inclusion: "I came to bring fire to the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!" (Luke 12:49). Sharing that passion for Jesus is something very few understand. It is the fire of the Holy Spirit within us.

Once again, Jesus' mission to the world is repeated: "To bring to earth the fire that kindles life and by which man is saved. Jesus calls us to spread this fire throughout the world, through which we will be recognized as his true disciples" (Pope Francis). Saint John Chrysostom (c. 350-407) said: "This is the fire of the Holy Spirit: He does not tolerate any worldly desire; instead, He leads us to another kind of love... In fact, when the power of this fire has entered the soul of man, it expels indifference and laziness." Allowing ourselves to be led by the Holy Spirit is the secret that prepares us to stand up for justice and peace. Jesus speaks of these divisions, referring to being at odds with one another in family and friends. Living the Gospel and bearing witness to it divides.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Jesus tells us that he has come to set fire to the earth. What can we give him as kindling? Let us look into our souls and see where the fire of Christ can be ignited, and pray that our souls may be consumed by its life-giving flames.

Dear God,

In the moments when my faith is met with others' disdain or ridicule, give me the grace to be grounded in You. Remind me that Your mission matters, and that You alone bring comfort, healing, and salvation. Amen

La forma como nos llevamos a veces en la familia y con los amigos es dolorosa: pleitos, venganzas, argumentos sin sentido, tan solo para herirnos. Alegamos por política, por deporte, por religión y más. Nos encendemos de la nada; pareciera que traemos fuego para discutir. Perdemos el control de la nada y por nada. Pero el fuego del que Jesús nos habla hoy es diferente. Es el fuego de la justicia, del perdón y de la inclusión: "He venido a traer fuego a la tierra, y ¡cuánto desearía que ya estuviera ardiendo!" (Lucas 12:49). Compartir esa pasión por Jesús es algo que muy pocos entienden. Se trata del fuego del Espíritu Santo en nosotros.

De nuevo se nos repite la misión de Jesús al mundo: "Traer a la tierra el fuego que enciende la vida y mediante el cual el hombre es salvado. Jesús nos llama a difundir en el mundo este fuego, gracias al cual seremos reconocidos como sus verdaderos discípulos" (Papa Francisco). San Juan Crisóstomo (c. 350-407) decía que: "Esto es el fuego del Espíritu Santo: él no tolera que se tenga algún deseo mundano; en cuanto, nos conduce a otro tipo de amor... De hecho, cuando la fuerza de este fuego ha entrado en el alma del hombre, éste expulsa la indiferencia y la pereza". Dejar-nos conducir por el Espíritu Santo es el secreto que nos dispone a dar la cara por la justicia y la paz. De esas divisiones habla Jesús, referente a estar en contra unos de otros en la familia y los amigos. Es que vivir el Evangelio y ser testigos de él dando testimonio divide.

VIVIR LA LITURGIA - INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA (Live the Liturgy)

Jesús nos dice que ha venido a prender fuego a la tierra. ¿Qué podemos darle como leña? Miremos dentro de nuestras almas y veamos dónde se puede encender el fuego de Cristo, y oremos para que nuestras almas sean consumidas por sus llamas vivificantes.

Dios mío,

En los momentos en que mi fe se encuentra con el desdén el ridículo de los demás, dame la gracia de centrarme en Ti. Recuérdame que Tu misión es importante, y que solo traes consuelo, sanación y salvación. Amén.
