

Throughout the Gospel, we find different passages where Jesus praises people who have faith. For example: "Get up, your faith has saved you" (Luke 17:19). A good challenge might be to read the four Gospels and take note of these passages, so that we can compare the people of that time with us today, regarding faith. What do we believe today? How can we measure the faith within us? Do we follow Jesus only to ask him for favors and miracles, or because we truly have faith in him?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in numbers 176 and 184, tells us the following about faith:

"Faith is a personal adherence of the whole person to God who reveals himself. It includes an adherence of the intellect and the will to the revelation that God has made of himself through his works and words." It adds: "Faith is a foretaste of the knowledge that will make us blessed in the life to come." The life of faith is not built in isolation. Many factors intervene in its growth. The first was given to us at baptism, and our parents and grandparents participated firsthand in its development. The community of faith is another essential factor. Then, the growth of faith depends on each individual. Today, let us make the same request the apostles made: "Lord, increase our faith." Surely, the response will be the same. Right?

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

The Apostles beg Jesus for increased faith, but they don't really want faith. They want a magical feeling of certainty that requires no effort. Real faith must grow and sprout roots in fertile soil. Real faith requires attention and work. Are we willing to work?

A lo largo del Evangelio encontramos diferentes pasajes donde Jesús elogia a las personas que tienen fe. Por ejemplo: "Levántate, tu fe te ha salvado" (Lucas 17:19). Un buen reto podría ser darnos a la tarea de leer los cuatro evangelios y tomar nota de estos pasajes, para así poder comparar a las personas de aquel tiempo con nosotros hoy, en lo que respecta a la fe. ¿En qué creemos actualmente? ¿Cómo podemos medir la fe que hay en nosotros? ¿Seguimos a Jesús solo para pedirle favores y que nos haga milagros, o porque de verdad tenemos fe en Él? El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en sus números 176 y 184, nos dice lo siguiente sobre la fe:

"La fe es una adhesión personal del hombre entero a Dios que se revela. Comprende una adhesión de la inteligencia y de la voluntad a la revelación que Dios ha hecho de sí mismo mediante sus obras y sus palabras". Y añade: "La fe es un gusto anticipado del conocimiento que nos hará bienaventurados en la vida futura". La vida de fe no se construve en solitario. Para su crecimiento, intervienen muchos factores. El primero nos fue dado desde el bautismo, y nuestros padres y abuelos participaron de primera mano en su desarrollo. La comunidad de fe es otro factor esencial. Después, el crecimiento de la fe depende de cada uno. Hoy, hagamos la misma petición que hicieron los apóstoles: "Señor, auméntanos la fe". Seguramente, la respuesta será la misma. ¿Verdad?

VIVIR LA LITURGIA - INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA

Los apóstoles le ruegan a Jesús que les aumente la fe, pero en realidad no quieren fe. Quieren una sensación mágica de certeza que no requiera esfuerzo. La verdadera fe debe crecer y echar raíces en tierra fértil. La verdadera fe requiere atención y trabajo. ¿Estamos dispuestos a trabajar?
