February 15, 2026

In today's Word of God, Jesus invites us to observe a more perfect law. He calls us to learn to fulfill it, giving concrete examples of how we should behave. Today's Psalm emphasizes the following: "Blessed are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord. Blessed are those who keep his statutes and seek him with all their heart" (Psalm 118:1-3). The joy of true happiness lies in knowing how to behave correctly in every circumstance of life. How can we achieve this? What should we hold onto to be truly happy? We heard the Beatitudes the Sunday before last, and with them, we have begun to practice living in that happiness that comes from God. Keeping the Lord's commands, that is, the Commandments, is the foundation of Christian morality and the sure path to God's wisdom. This means being connected with Him always, through prayer and the sacraments.

Saint Leo the Great, in his sermon number 92 (1, 2, 3), said: "Christian virtue can surpass that of the scribes and Pharisees, not by abolishing the law, but by understanding it in a deeper sense. Therefore, the Lord, when teaching his disciples how to fast, says to them: 'When you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, who disfigure their faces to show others that they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have already received their reward.' What reward, but the praise of men?" Lord, teach us to be open wholeheartedly to your Spirit, for only He can move us to practice love, justice, and peace.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Jesus does not want us to live within the law — he wants the law to live within us. God's law, fulfilled by His Son, is rich soil. We must let it nourish the words and the decisions of our Christian life — only then will it flow forth into the world.

En la Palabra de Dios de hoy, Jesús nos invita a observar una ley más perfecta. Nos llama a aprender a cumplirla, dando ejemplos concretos de cómo debemos comportarnos. El Salmo de hoy nos recalca lo siguiente: "Felices los de conducta intachable, los que caminan en la ley del Señor. Felices los que guardan sus mandatos y lo buscan de todo corazón" (Salmo 118:1-3). La dicha de ser feliz consiste en saber comportarse correctamente en cada circunstancia de la vida. ¿Cómo lograrlo? ¿A qué debemos aferrarnos para ser verdaderamente felices? Ya escuchamos las Bienaventuranzas el domingo antepasado, y con ellas hemos comenzado a practicar cómo vivir en esa felicidad que proviene de Dios. Guardar los mandatos del Señor, es decir, los Mandamientos, es la base de la moral cristiana, y el camino seguro hacia la Sabiduría de Dios. Esto significa estar conectados con Él siempre, por medio de la oración y los sacramentos.

San León Magno, en su sermón número 92 (1, 2, 3), decía: "La virtud cristiana puede superar la de los escribas y fariseos, no por la supresión de la ley, sino por entenderla en un sentido más profundo. Por eso el Señor, al enseñar a sus discípulos la manera de ayunar, les dice: 'Cuando ayunen, no anden cabizbajos como los hipócritas, que desfiguran su rostro para hacer ver a la gente que ayunan. Les aseguro que ya han recibido su paga.' ¿Qué paga, sino la alabanza de los hombres?" Señor, enséñanos a estar abiertos de todo corazón a tu Espíritu, ya que solo Él podrá empujarnos a practicar el amor, la justicia y la paz.

VIVIR LA LITURGIA - INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA

Jesús no quiere que vivamos dentro de la ley, quiere que la ley viva dentro de nosotros. La ley de Dios, cumplida por Su Hijo, es tierra rica. Debemos dejar que alimente las palabras y las decisiones de nuestra vida cristiana, solo entonces fluirá hacia el mundo.

LENTEN DISCIPLINES OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE


Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

As you know, the Michigan City parishes are in the process of merging into one parish. As part of this merger, the Queen of All Saints campus will serve as the anchor site, with the other locations designated as worship sites. While this terminology can sound a bit ambiguous, among other things, it means that parish operations will be centralized in one main office.

In light of this change, Brandi Hoffman, the secretary at Notre Dame, will be working three days a week at the Queen of All Saints campus. This change will take effect during the first week of February. As a result, the parish office at Notre Dame will be open only on Mondays.

If you need to conduct parish business on any day other than Monday, please visit the central parish office located at 606 S. Woodland Avenue on the Queen of All Saints campus.
