September 7, 2025

To follow Jesus, we must make certain changes in our lives, which involve leaving our comfort zone. Giving up things and situations we're not used to, we think, is almost impossible. But remember, nothing is impossible for God. It only takes a little effort on our part. Letting go of our whims, quirks, and bad habits that oppose the Gospel is a matter of work and progress. That's what it takes to follow Jesus! "Whoever does not take up his cross and follow me cannot be my disciple" (Luke 14:27).

Pope Francis, in his catechesis, helps us understand Jesus' message so that our burden may be lightened and we may appreciate the cross we carry in our lives. "There are three characteristics that clearly define Jesus' personality and motivate our trust in him: we entrust ourselves to him because he prays, because he has chosen us, and because he is close to us. Jesus prayed for us and continues to pray for us: he is the intercessor. Jesus loves and chooses with love; he chooses us all. And God's closeness to his people is Jesus' closeness to people." Jesus cares about our freedom; he doesn't want us to follow him blindly. Carrying the cross means measuring and calculating our strength and realizing how much fidelity to his teachings exists in our hearts. Help me, with your grace, when I falter, when I am alone and confused, when I am without hope. Do you want to follow Jesus? Well, go ahead, he is always waiting for you.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Today, Jesus tells us the cost of true discipleship — and it turns out, it's everything. We must reject the world in order to love God. What attachments are holding us back from the relationship we could have — we *should* have — with our Lord

Para seguir a Jesús debemos realizar ciertos cambios en la vida, que implican salir de nuestro confort. Dejar nuestros caprichos, manías y malos hábitos que se oponen al Evangelio es cosa de trabajo y proceso. ¡Eso cuesta seguir a Jesús! *"El que no carga con su propia cruz para seguirme no puede ser discípulo mío"* (Lucas 14:27).

El Papa Francisco, en su catequesis, nos ayuda a comprender el mensaje de Jesús para que nuestra carga sea ligera y apreciemos la cruz que llevamos en nuestra vida. *"Hay tres características que trazan claramente la personalidad de Jesús y que motivan nuestra confianza en Él: nos encomendamos a Él porque ora, porque nos ha elegido y porque está cerca de nosotros. Jesús ha pedido y sigue pidiendo por nosotros: es el intercesor. Jesús ama y elige con amor, nos elige a todos. Y la cercanía de Dios a su pueblo es la cercanía de Jesús con la gente"*. A Jesús le importa nuestra libertad, no quiere que lo sigamos a ciegas. Cargar con la cruz quiere decir medir y calcular las fuerzas que tenemos y darnos cuenta de cuánta fidelidad a sus enseñanzas existe en nuestro corazón. Ayúdame, con tu gracia, cuando flaqueo, cuando estoy solo y confundido, cuando estoy sin esperanza. ¿Quieres seguir a Jesús? Pues, adelante, Él te espera siempre.

CARLO ACUTIS CANONIZATION

SEPTEMBER 7, 2025



CARLO ACUTIS

STANDING ENDOWMENT ON
CREDO

Pope Leo XIV announced that Carlo Acutis, a teenage computer aficionado dubbed "God's influencer," would be canonized on Sept. 7, making him the Roman Catholic Church's first millennial saint.

Described as exceptionally smart and internet savvy, with typical teenage interests, Carlo also had a deeply spiritual side. He attended church every day,

set up a website listing miracles attributed to the eucharist and carried out countless acts of kindness, according to his biographers and the people who championed his cause for sainthood.

His brief but exemplary life struck a chord with the faithful, and since his 2020 beatification his tomb in Assisi has drawn multitudes of pilgrims. Leading up to his canonization, two miracles were attributed to Carlo's intercession: the healing of a 4-year-old boy in Brazil with a malformed pancreas and the recovery of a 21-year-old Costa Rican university student who suffered severe head trauma after falling off her bicycle in Florence. Since his beatification, chapels and schools have been dedicated to him throughout the world.

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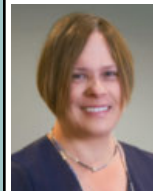


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
