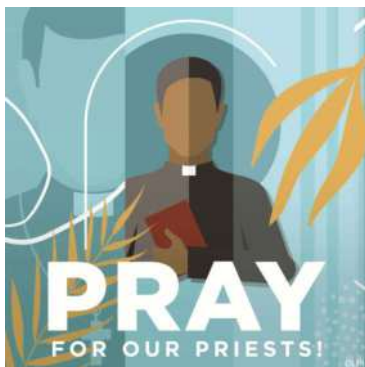

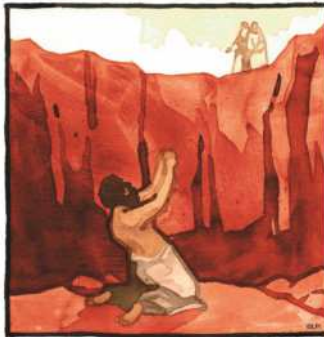

September 28, 2025

A huge gulf still exists between the poor and the rich, between the Lazaruses and the rich of our time. Who are they? Where are they? They are mixed together, because there are rich people so poor that we don't recognize them; they, from their wealth, quietly share their possessions with those in need. And we can find poor people so rich because of their selfish way of living and harboring resentment in their hearts. "And between you and us there is a great gulf, so that those who would cross from here to you cannot, and those from you cannot cross to us" (Luke 16:26). Here it is about internalizing the Word of God and realizing that we are represented in both characters. And the important thing is to help people in their different needs, not to turn a deaf ear, as if nothing were happening. Saint Augustine, in his Sermon 33 on the Old Testament, says the following: "Listen to the Gospel, look, and examine the thoughts of the two men in the parable: There was a rich man who dressed in purple and linen and dined sumptuously every day... But a beggar named Lazarus was lying at the entrance of his house. He didn't mention the name of the rich man, but he did mention the name of the poor man. God omitted the name of the one who was on everyone's lips, while he mentioned the name of the one who was omitted." Do you think God mentions your name? Or do you think He does?

Mini reflection: The parable of the rich man and Lazarus highlights a reality that we often wish to ignore: at some point, we will run out of chances, and it's not because God tires of giving them to us.



Mini Reflexión: La parábola del rico y Lázaro pone de relieve una realidad que muchas veces queremos ignorar: en algún momento nos quedaremos sin oportunidades, y no es porque Dios se canse de darnoslas.

28 de septiembre de 2025

Un abismo enorme sigue existiendo entre la línea del pobre y del rico, entre los Lázaros y los ricos de nuestro tiempo. ¿Quiénes son? ¿Dónde están? Están mezclados, porque existen ricos tan pobres que no los conocemos; ellos, de su riqueza, comparten sus bienes calladamente con quienes los necesitan. Y podemos encontrar pobres tan ricos por su modo de vivir egoístamente y por almacenar rencor en su corazón. "Además, entre ustedes y nosotros hay un abismo tremendo, de tal manera que los que quieran cruzar desde aquí hasta ustedes no pueden hacerlo, y tampoco lo pueden hacer del lado de ustedes al nuestro" (Lucas 16:26). Aquí se trata de interiorizar la Palabra de Dios y darnos cuenta de que estamos representados en los dos personajes. Y lo importante es ayudar a la gente en sus diferentes necesidades, no hacernos sordos, como si no ocurriera nada.

San Agustín, en su Sermón 33 sobre el Antiguo Testamento, dice lo siguiente: "Escucha el evangelio, mira y examina los pensamientos de los dos hombres de la parábola: Había un hombre rico que se vestía de púrpura y lino y banqueteaba espléndidamente cada día... En cambio, un mendigo llamado Lázaro yacía a la entrada de su casa. No mencionó el nombre del rico, pero sí dijo el nombre del pobre. Dios calló el nombre del que andaba en boca de todos, mientras que mencionó el nombre del que todos callaban". ¿Crees que Dios menciona tu nombre? ¿O crees que lo calla?

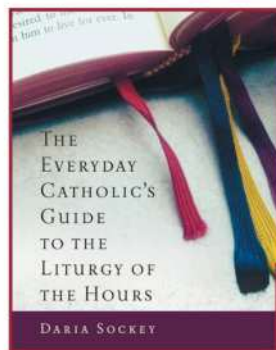

Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP), describes the Knights of Columbus' efforts to support pregnant women, mothers and their babies by serving pregnancy resource centers and maternity homes.

On October 4th and 5th the Knights of Columbus will be begin a Baby Bottle Drive. As the name suggests, the drive uses baby bottles to collect loose change, cash and checks.

You will see Knights at the doors of the church handing out Baby Bottles for you to take home and fill and bring back on November 1st and 2nd.

The money collected will be donated to the Prenatal Assistance Program and the Women's Care Center to support and provide supplies to mothers who choose to have their babies and not have an abortion.

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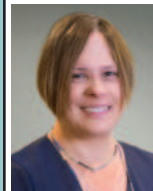
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
