

# Gospel Meditation/Meditación del evangelio

### November 23, 2025

With the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, the liturgical year comes to an end.

Next week we will begin Advent, and then joyfully celebrate Christ-

With this solemnity, the Church recalls the sovereignty of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe: "Jesus' entry into Jerusalem manifests the coming of the Kingdom that the King-Messiah, received into his city by the children and the humble of heart, is going to accomplish by the Passover of his Death and Resurrection" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 570). Jesus, You are our King, from the cross where You cruelly died for us to save us. Blessed and adored be You forever!

"When our Savior was hanging on the glorious cross, two thieves were with Him. What can be deduced from this? Undoubtedly, it was a mockery, according to the plan devised by the Jews, but it was also a fulfillment of the prophecy: 'I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death and was numbered with the transgressors' (Isaiah 53:12)... He paid the debts for us, bore our sins, and was scourged for us, as it is written: 'By his wounds we are healed, for he bore our sins' (Isaiah 53:5). And He delivered us from the diseases of the soul" (Saint Cyril of Alexandria [375-444], Commentary on the Gospel of Luke). Long live Christ the King!

Our king wears a crown of thorns, not a crown of gold. His glory is not in riches but in suffering. His law is written in his own blood. shed for the love of us. Do we understand the gift that it is, to be subject to such a king?

"Cuando nuestro Salvador estaba colgado en la gloriosa cruz, estaban con Él dos ladrones. ¿Qué se puede deducir de esto? Sin lugar a dudas, se trataba de una burla, de acuerdo con el plan tomado por los judíos, pero también era un cumplimiento de la profecía: 'Le daré su parte entre los grandes y con los poderosos repartirá despojos, pues se entregó indefenso a la muerte y fue tenido por un malhechor' (Isaías 53:12) ... Él pagó las deudas por nosotros, cargó con nuestros pecados y fue azotado por nosotros, según está escrito: 'Por sus sufrimientos fuimos curados, pues Él cargó con nuestros pecados' (Isaías 53:5). Y nos libró de las enfermedades del alma" (San Cirilo de Alejandría [375–444], Comentario al Evangelio de Lucas). ¡Que viva Cristo Rev!




