November 2, 2025

Today we remember our deceased relatives and friends. We lift up our prayers with the words of Psalm 130: "Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord: O Lord, hear my voice! Let your ears be attentive to the cry of my supplications." In this way, the Church commemorates all the faithful departed.

Pope Francis tells us: "The Commemoration of the Dead has a double meaning. One meaning is sadness: a cemetery is sad, it reminds us of our loved ones who have passed away, it also reminds us of the future, of death; but in this sadness, we bring flowers, as a sign of hope. I can also say of celebration, but later, not now. And sadness mingles with hope. And this is what we all feel today, in this celebration: the memory of our loved ones, before their remains, and hope. But we also feel that this hope helps us, because we too must walk this path. All of us will walk this path. Sooner or later, but all of us. With pain, more or less pain, but all of us. But with the flower of hope, with that strong thread that is anchored in the hereafter. This anchor does not disappoint: the hope of the resurrection." There should be no doubt that the Gospel confirms this anchor, which is Jesus and his promise of eternal life: "Everyone who believes in the Son will have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day" (John 6:40).

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

To live with Christ, we must die with him. But what does this mean? What does this look like in the ordinary life of a Christian? We must ask God for the wisdom to see our own crosses, so that we may carry them into the newness of life.

Puedo decir, también, de fiesta, pero más adelante, no ahora. Y la tristeza se mezcla con la esperanza. Y esto es lo que todos nosotros sentimos hoy, en esta celebración: la memoria de nuestros seres queridos, ante sus restos, y la esperanza. Pero sentimos también que esta esperanza nos ayuda, porque también nosotros tenemos que recorrer este camino. Todos nosotros recorreremos este camino. Antes o después, pero todos. Con dolor, más o menos dolor, pero todos. Pero con la flor de la esperanza, con ese hilo fuerte que está anclado en el más allá. Esta ancla no decepciona: la esperanza de la resurrección". No debe existir ninguna duda, el Evangelio confirma esta ancla, que es Jesús y su promesa de vida eterna: "Toda persona que al contemplar al Hijo crea en Él, tendrá vida eterna, y yo la resucitaré en el último día" (Juan 6:40).

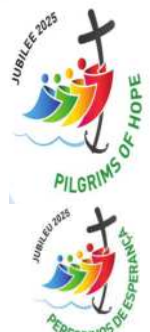
