Perseverance, what does this important word mean? It means remaining steadfast in our plans and good intentions. Persevering in our studies, at work, and in family relationships requires enthusiasm and energy every day. Nothing is easy, and today Jesus invites us not to be afraid in the face of the adversities and catastrophes we currently see, but to overcome trials with faith and trust in a God who does not disappoint: "Not a hair of your head will perish." And he adds another phrase that invites us to awaken from spiritual lethargy: "Stand firm, and you will gain your lives" (Luke 21:18-19).

Today's liturgy helps us reflect on the many betrayals, famines, and wars that afflict our brothers and sisters in the world. However, despite all that, we walk with hope. Nothing and no one can take away our certainty that God is walking beside us. But we must not be deceived by letting time pass without doing anything for our own good and the good of others. "The deception is believing ourselves to be masters of time. Time is not ours. There is only one sovereign of time: Jesus Christ. Do not be deceived in the confusion. The Christian moves along this path of the present moment, with prayer and discernment. But he leaves time to hope. The Christian knows how to wait for the Lord at every moment; but he waits for the Lord at the end of time" (Pope Francis).

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Jesus' words today are filled with fire and brimstone, vivid with images of pain, suffering, confusion — and, ultimately, peace. Do we believe what he promises? Do we have the endurance to stay with him until the end?

Nada es fácil, y hoy Jesús nos invita a no tener miedo ante las adversidades y catástrofes que vemos actualmente, sino a superar las pruebas con fe y confianza en un Dios que no defrauda: *"Con todo, ni un cabello de su cabeza se perderá"*. Y agrega otra frase que nos invita a despertar del letargo espiritual: *"Manténganse firmes y se salvarán"* (Lucas 21:18-19).

La liturgia de hoy nos ayuda a reflexionar sobre las muchas traiciones, hambres y guerras que azotan a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en el mundo. Sin embargo, a pesar de todo eso, caminamos con esperanza. Nada ni nadie puede arrebatarnos la seguridad de que Dios está caminando a nuestro lado. Pero no debemos dejarnos engañar dejando pasar el tiempo sin hacer nada por nuestro bien y el de los demás. *"El engaño es creernos dueños del tiempo. El tiempo no es nuestro. Del tiempo existe solo un soberano: Jesucristo. No os dejéis engañar en la confusión. El cristiano se mueve por este camino del momento, con la oración y el discernimiento. Pero deja el tiempo a la esperanza. El cristiano sabe esperar al Señor en cada momento; pero espera en el Señor al final de los tiempos"* (Papa Francisco).

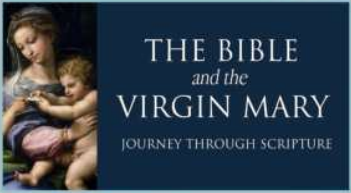

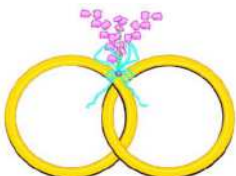

While our pantry is open for just over two hours, two times per week. Our ability to serve our community is due to our "engine" of volunteers working behind the scenes. Tuesdays and Thursdays and often Mondays and Fridays, our volunteers work hours and hours to make our time with customers possible and productive. 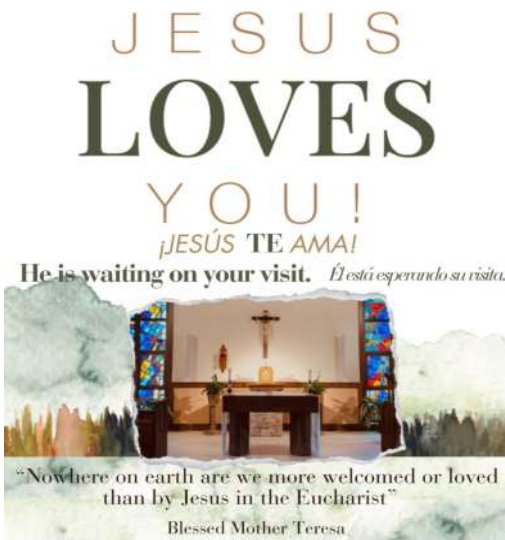

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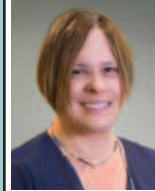
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
