We all like to make plans, have goals, and achieve them. This makes us happy because things are going well for us in life, and we think, "Great! I've worked so hard that now I can enjoy what I have." But we forget the most important thing: we never count on You when it comes to goals. We forget that only You, Lord, will give us true freedom and happiness. Life is not about possessing possessions. "Avoid every kind of covetousness, for even if a person has everything, it is not his possessions that give him life" (Luke 12:15).

It's worth asking ourselves: What is the center of your life? What is the goal in your life? Is your happiness in what you possess, in your social status, in what people will say about you? Be careful, Jesus warns us: "This very night you will die. Who will take what you have prepared?" (Luke 12:20).

"Jesus perceives our problems, our weaknesses, our needs; he invites us to convert to faith in Providence, to know how to share the little we are and have, and never to close ourselves off" (Pope Francis). Having many possessions and prestige is not evil; what God desires is for us to learn to be selfless, that is, generous. Let us not mistake our life plan; abundance is fleeting; everything remains when we die. Only spiritual riches will be eternal. "This is true of everyone who hoards for themselves rather than for God" (Luke 12:21).

A todos nos gusta hacer planes, tener metas y llegar a ellas. Eso nos pone contentos porque nos va bien en la vida y pensamos: "Qué bien, he luchado tanto que ya puedo disfrutar de lo que tengo". Pero nos olvidamos de lo más importante: en las metas nunca contamos contigo. Nos olvidamos de que sólo Tú, Señor, nos darás la auténtica libertad y felicidad. No está la vida en poseer bienes. *"Eviten con gran cuidado toda clase de codicia, porque, aunque uno tenga todo, no son sus posesiones las que le dan vida"* (Lucas 12:15).

Vale preguntarnos: ¿Cuál es el centro de tu vida? ¿Cuál es la meta en tu vida? ¿Está tu felicidad en lo que posees, en tu estatus social, en lo que dirá la gente de ti? Cuidado, nos advierte Jesús: *"Esta misma noche vas a morir. ¿Quién se quedará con lo que has preparado?"* (Lucas 12:20).

"Jesús percibe nuestros problemas, nuestras debilidades, nuestras necesidades; invita a convertimos a la fe en la Providencia, saber compartir lo poco que somos y tenemos, y no cerrarnos nunca en nosotros mismos" (Papa Francisco). El tener muchos bienes y prestigio no es malo, lo que Dios desea es que aprendamos a ser desprendidos, es decir, generosos. No equivoquemos el proyecto de nuestra vida; la abundancia es pasajera, todo se queda al morir. Solo las riquezas espirituales serán eternas. *"Esto vale para toda persona que amontona para sí misma en vez de acumular para Dios"* (Lucas 12:21).

Offertory Gifts



Carrying the gifts to the altar is a beautiful experience; you can play an integral part in the sacrifice of Mass. If you have offered a Mass for your loved one and would like to present the gifts during the offertory, please see an usher 10 minutes before Mass begins to inform them of your wishes.

We like to reserve this special part of Mass for the family and/or friends of the listed Mass intention.

Communion to the sick and/or handicapped. If you are unable to walk in the communion line and want to receive Holy Communion during Mass, please see an usher prior to the start of Mass so they can direct the EMHC to your location. You may also want to sit in the front row which is reserved for these individuals.

A Mass intention is a specific petition for which the Mass is offered. Mass intentions can be requested on behalf of another living person—for example, for healing or to commemorate a wedding anniversary. However, Mass intentions are most commonly offered in remembrance of a person who has died.

Offering a Mass for the deceased may seem counterintuitive for a person who has died, as their time on earth is finished. We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God. It is especially important to pray for the dead, as they can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering the celebration of the Eucharist for the dead “is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones.”

There are still opportunities in August at Notre Dame for Mass Intentions for your loved ones. Please call the church office to offer Masses for your special intentions.




