

Gospel Meditation/Meditación del evangelio

October 26, 2025

Before God, we cannot pretend or feign: He knows us deeply. No matter how good our face is, He sees beyond: He sees our hearts. Nor can we tell Him how good we are, because He knows us and our actions perfectly. Today, Jesus tells us another parable: that of two men who went to the temple to pray. Each one does it in his own way, and when we listen to the story, we realize that one does it better than the other. But the most important thing is that both speak to God. With this example, we can learn to pray and to present ourselves before God just as we are. "Indeed, the Pharisee, despite his works, lost righteousness; the tax collector, on the other hand, earned righteousness through the humility of his words. Although, to tell the truth, the tax collector's humility was not truly humility: in fact, humility occurs when someone who is great humbles himself. The tax collector's attitude was not humility, but truth: his words were true, for he was a sinner." – Saint John Chrysostom (350-407), Homily 2 on Penance.

"But, even though we are sinners, we must not be discouraged, because the Lord is with us, who has given us everything and will enable us to overcome even this small step today, with the grace of strength, courage, prayer, vigilance, and joy" (Pope Francis). In conclusion: it may be that a Pharisee and a tax collector live within each of us. Both need God to be freed and forgiven. Before God, let us pray with truth and sincerity of heart.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

The Pharisee took such pride in his good deeds that he forgot to ask God for forgiveness; the tax collector acknowledged his many sins, and went home justified. Remember that we are saved not by our own merit, but by the mercy of God.

26 de octubre de 2025

Ante Dios no podemos fingir ni aparentar: Él nos conoce profundamente. Por más cara de buenos que pongamos, Él ve más allá: ve nuestro corazón. Tampoco podemos decirle cuán buenos somos, porque nos conoce y sabe perfectamente nuestras acciones. Hoy, Jesús nos cuenta otra parábola: la de dos hombres que fueron al templo a orar. Cada uno lo hace a su manera, y al escuchar el relato, nos damos cuenta de que uno lo hace mejor que el otro. Pero lo más importante es que los dos hablan con Dios. Con este ejemplo podemos aprender a orar y a presentarnos ante Dios tal como somos. "Efectivamente, el fariseo, a pesar de las obras, perdió la justicia; el publicano, en cambio, se granjeó la justicia por la humildad de sus palabras. Aunque, a decir verdad, la del publicano no era propiamente humildad: de hecho, la humildad se da cuando uno que es grande se humilla a sí mismo. La actitud del publicano no fue humildad, sino verdad: sus palabras eran verdaderas, pues él era un pecador"- San Juan Crisóstomo (350–407), Homilía 2 sobre la Penitencia.

"Pero, aunque somos pecadores, no debemos desalentarnos, porque el Señor está con nosotros, quien nos ha dado todo y nos hará vencer también este pequeño paso de hoy, con la gracia de la fuerza, de la valentía, de la oración, de la vigilancia y de la alegría" (Papa Francisco). En conclusión: puede ser que en cada uno de nosotros vivan un fariseo y un publicano. Ambos necesitan de Dios para ser liberados y perdonados. Ante Dios, oremos con verdad y con sinceridad de corazón.

El fariseo se enorgullecía tanto de sus buenas obras que se olvidó de pedirle perdón a Dios; El recaudador de impuestos reconoció sus muchos pecados y se fue a casa justificado. Recuerda que no somos salvos por nuestros propios méritos, sino por la misericordia de Dios.



October Red Cross Blood Drive and Walgreens Flu Clinic!




