#### Are You Talking to Me?

Last summer I was at the National Eucharistic Congress when Fr. Mike Schmitz delivered an impassioned call to repentance in his keynote address during an evening revival session. The crowd received his message with great enthusiasm. Their applause and the cheers shook the Lucas Oil Stadium.

The next night, Sr. Josephine Garrett took the stage and, in her address, got into the nitty-gritty of what it means to be a disciple, what it means to live repentance — or, as she so beautifully put it, to *embrace the hunger*.

And in doing so, she called back to the previous night's thunderous approval of Fr. Mike's message.

"When I heard you clapping when Father said we need repentance, I was worried you thought he was talking about your neighbor's repentance," she said. "He is not."

In other words: he's talking about your repentance.

We all love a message about The Right Thing To Do. We all love when a priest or a nun or any Catholic with a microphone gets up and talks about the truth. We rise to our feet and applaud. And then, too often, we take a deep breath and walk to our car and forget all about it — because we think they were talking to someone else. You know...the *others*. The ones who need to hear it. The ones who aren't being vigilant.

In today's Gospel, Peter asks Jesus, "Is this parable [of the absent master] meant for us, or for everyone?" (Luke 12:41). And Jesus answers him with a question. In so many words, he says this: "Do you want it to be for you? Are you ready to hear it?"

Whoever we are. Wherever we're from. Whatever our life looks like. However we pray. He's talking to us.

Are we ready to hear him?

#### 10 de agosto de 2025 ¿Me Estás Hablando a Mí?

El verano pasado estuve en el Congreso Eucarístico Nacional cuando el P. Mike Schmitz hizo un apasionado llamado al arrepentimiento en su discurso de apertura durante una sesión vespertina de avivamiento. La multitud recibió su mensaje con gran entusiasmo. Sus aplausos y vítores hicieron temblar el Lucas Oil Stadium. La noche siguiente, Sor Josephine Garrett subió al escenario y, en su discurso, se metió en el meollo de lo que significa ser un discípulo, lo que significa vivir el arrepentimiento o, como ella lo expresó tan bellamente. abrazar el hambre.

Y al hacerlo, recordó la estruendosa aprobación del mensaje del P. Mike de la noche anterior.

"Cuando te escuché aplaudir, cuando padre dijo que necesitamos arrepentimiento, me preocupó que pensaras que estaba hablando del arrepentimiento de tu prójimo", dijo. —No lo está.

En otras palabras: él está hablando de tu arrepentimiento.

A todos nos encanta un mensaje sobre lo correcto que hay que hacer. A todos nos encanta cuando un sacerdote o una monja o cualquier católico con un micrófono se levanta y habla de la verdad. Nos ponemos de pie y aplaudimos.

Y luego, con demasiada frecuencia, respiramos hondo y caminamos hacia nuestro auto y nos olvidamos de todo, porque pensamos que estaban hablando con otra persona. Tú sabes... los *demás*. Los que necesitan escucharlo. Los que no están siendo vigilantes.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Pedro le pregunta a Jesús: "¿Esta parábola [del maestro ausente] es para nosotros o para todos?" (Lucas 12:41). Y Jesús le responde con una pregunta. En pocas palabras, dice esto: "¿Quieres que sea para ti? ¿Estás listo para escucharlo?"

Quienquiera que seamos. Seamos de donde seamos. Sea lo que sea nuestra vida. Como sea que oremos. Él nos está hablando a nosotros.

¿Estamos listos para escucharlo?

Carrying the gifts to the altar is a beautiful experience; you can play an integral part in the sacrifice of Mass. If you have offered a Mass for your loved one and would like to present the gifts during the offertory, please see an usher 10 minutes before Mass begins to inform them of your wishes.

We like to reserve this special part of Mass for the family and/or friends of the listed Mass intention.

Communion to the sick and/or handicapped. If you are unable to walk in the communion line and want to receive Holy Communion during Mass, please see an usher prior to the start of Mass so they can direct the EMHC to your location. You may also want to sit in the front row which is reserved for the these individuals.

A Mass intention is a specific petition for which the Mass is offered. Mass intentions can be requested on behalf of another living person—for example, for healing or to commemorate a wedding anniversary. However, Mass intentions are most commonly offered in remembrance of a person who has died.

Offering a Mass for the deceased may seem counterintuitive for a person who has died, as their time on earth is finished. We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God. It is especially important to pray for the dead, as they can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering the celebration of the Eucharist for the dead "is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones."

There are still opportunities in August at Notre Dame for Mass Intentions for your loved ones. Please call the church office to offer Masses for your special intentions.
