September 21, 2025

The manager in the parable Jesus tells us today is astute. He tells us that he managed to make friends among his master's debtors because he forgave part of their debt. He is praised for being so agile with other people's property. "The master admired the cleverness of the manager who had defrauded him" (Luke 16:8). You can't exploit people for money and claim to love God, especially in these modern times, where everything seems to be going well. However, immigrants from every country in the world are widely exploited. Human trafficking, unfair wages, and debts from poor countries that are impossible to pay are rife. To mention a few examples. "There is a Christian cunning in doing things cunningly, but not in the spirit of the world: doing things honestly. And this is good. This is what Jesus says when he invites us to be as cunning as serpents and as innocent as doves. Bringing these two dimensions together is a grace of the Holy Spirit, a grace we must ask for. Even today there are many of these swindlers, corrupt people... I am shocked to see how corruption is widespread everywhere" (Pope Francis). Pope Francis is right to be shocked and at the same time concerned by so much dishonesty in our society. We must take action and realize that you cannot serve God and money. That's what Jesus said, and his message is as valid then as it is now.

Mini reflection: Jesus' parable of the untrustworthy steward sums up all our anxieties surrounding material wealth and the delicate balance we have to strike of caring for our physical needs while prioritizing our spiritual ones.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

No servant can serve two masters, and in his goodness, God gives us the ability to choose. Will we serve mammon, the riches of this world? Or will we seek true wealth, the kind that cannot be hoarded or wasted, but only given freely away?

Astuto el administrador de la parábola que Jesús nos cuenta hoy. Nos dice que consiguió hacer amigos entre los deudores de su amo, porque les perdonó parte de su deuda. Es elogiado por ser tan ágil en bienes ajenos. "El patrón admiró la manera tan inteligente de actuar de ese administrador que lo estafaba" (Lucas 16:8). No se puede explotar a las personas por dinero y decir que se ama a Dios, especialmente en estos tiempos modernos, donde aparentemente todo funciona bien. Sin embargo, se explota mucho a los inmigrantes de cualquier país del mundo. Abunda la trata de personas, los salarios injustos y las deudas de países pobres imposibles de pagar. Por mencionar algunos ejemplos.

"Existe una astucia cristiana de hacer las cosas con picardía, pero no con el espíritu del mundo: hacer las cosas honestamente. Y esto es bueno. Es lo que dice Jesús cuando invita a ser astutos como serpientes y simples como palomas. Poner juntas estas dos dimensiones es una gracia del Espíritu Santo, una gracia que debemos pedir. También hoy hay muchos de estos estafadores, corruptos... A mí me impresiona ver cómo la corrupción está extendida por todas partes" (Papa Francisco). Tiene razón el Papa Francisco al estar impresionado y a la vez preocupado por tanta deshonestidad en nuestra sociedad. Tenemos que poner acción y darnos cuenta de que no se puede servir a Dios y al dinero. Así lo dijo Jesús, y su mensaje vale tanto entonces como ahora.

Mini Reflexión: La parábola de Jesús del administrador indigno de confianza resume todas nuestras ansiedades en torno a la riqueza material y el delicado equilibrio que tenemos que lograr entre el cuidado de nuestras necesidades físicas y la priorización de las espirituales

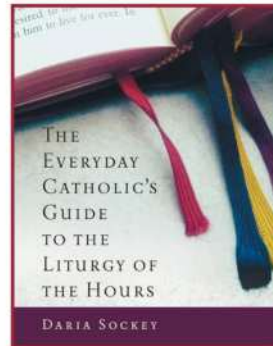

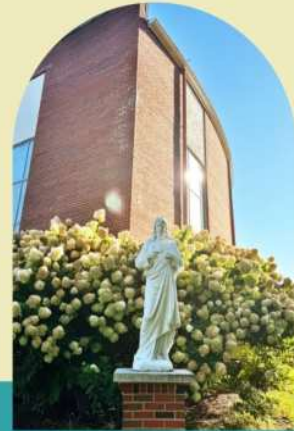

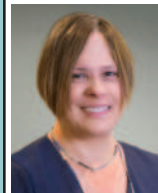
