**November 30, 2025**

Advent is a liturgical season of great hope. Today we begin Cycle A, and the Gospel of Matthew will guide us through this time of grace. Matthew, also called Levi, was one of those whom Jesus chose as his twelve apostles. He will help us see that hope is closer than ever; that the proclamation of peace consists of: Be alert, do not sleep, keep watch until nightfall. "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day the Lord will come" (Matthew 24:42). Another year has arrived, and we are invited not to be afraid, but rather to be ready to awaken, pay attention, and watch, to discover and follow how God will work in our lives this Advent.

Hope and vigilance are what the Church proposes to us in this jubilee, and Advent is the time to be awake, like the shepherds who listened to the news that a Savior had been born in the city of David. In what ways will I be awake this Advent? Perhaps I will receive Christ differently than in other years, with a spirit of vigilance and commitment to my family and my community. Jesus, help me turn my heart toward you, so that in doing so I may see with new eyes the search for truth and justice that we so desperately need in our families and in society. Come, Lord!

## LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

"You do not know on which day your Lord will come," Jesus says. He is reminding us that we do not know the mind of God. But we do know the heart of God, and we know that it is filled with mercy for those who heed the warning: Stay awake!

*Esperanza y vigilia es lo que la Iglesia nos propone en este jubileo, y el Adviento es el momento de estar despiertos, como los pastores que supieron escuchar la noticia de que, en la ciudad de David, había nacido un Salvador. ¿De qué formas estaré despierto o despierta en este Adviento?*

*Puede ser que reciba a Cristo de una forma diferente a otros años, con un espíritu de vigilancia y compromiso hacia mi familia y mi comunidad. Jesús, ayúdame a girar mi corazón hacia ti, para que al hacerlo pueda ver con una mirada nueva la búsqueda de la verdad y la justicia que tanto necesitamos en la familia y en la sociedad. ¡Ven, Señor!*

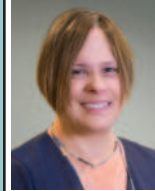
