December 28, 2025

Jesus and his family know what it means to emigrate, to change places, and to move quickly because they are being persecuted. They experienced firsthand the effects of this situation. Perhaps we have a family member or friend who is currently suffering the hardships of leaving their home, school, or job. Joseph and Mary fled because of the threat of danger hanging over them: "Get up, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, for Herod is going to search for the child to kill him" (Matthew 2:13). Father, mother, and son fled to where God directed them, to save the child. This is a true reflection of what the Holy Family of Nazareth represents. Celebrating the Feast of the Holy Family during Christmas should fill us with hope, wishing that our own families may be a place where love and joy prevail among its members. How do I welcome the families of my brothers and sisters today? How is my relationship with them?

"You, families, are the hope of the Church and of the world. With your witness to the Gospel, you can help God realize his dream; you can contribute to bringing all of God's children closer together, so that they may grow in unity and learn what it means for the whole world to live in peace as one great family" (Pope Francis). Let us pray for our families, hoping that, on this day dedicated to the Family of Nazareth, we may imitate their hope in God and their unity at all times.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

God created the Holy Family with a great sense of purpose, because he knew that Jesus would be defined by the woman and man who raised him. Who is our "Holy Family" — the people who will define us? Who has God placed within our lives for a specific purpose?

Este es un fiel reflejo de lo que representa la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret. Celebrar la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia durante la Navidad debe animarnos con esperanza, deseando que nuestras propias familias sean un lugar donde se respire amor y alegría entre sus miembros. ¿Cómo recibo hoy a las familias de mis hermanos y hermanas? ¿Cómo es mi convivencia con ellos?

"Ustedes, familias, son la esperanza de la Iglesia y del mundo. Con su testimonio del Evangelio pueden ayudar a Dios a realizar su sueño; pueden contribuir a acercar a todos los hijos de Dios, para que crezcan en la unidad y aprendan qué significa para el mundo entero vivir en paz como una gran familia" (Papa Francisco). Oremos por nuestras familias, deseando que, en este día dedicado a la Familia de Nazaret, imitemos su esperanza en Dios y su unidad en todo momento.

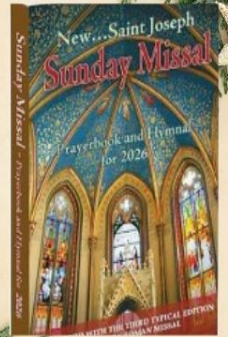

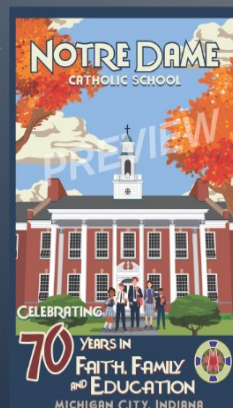

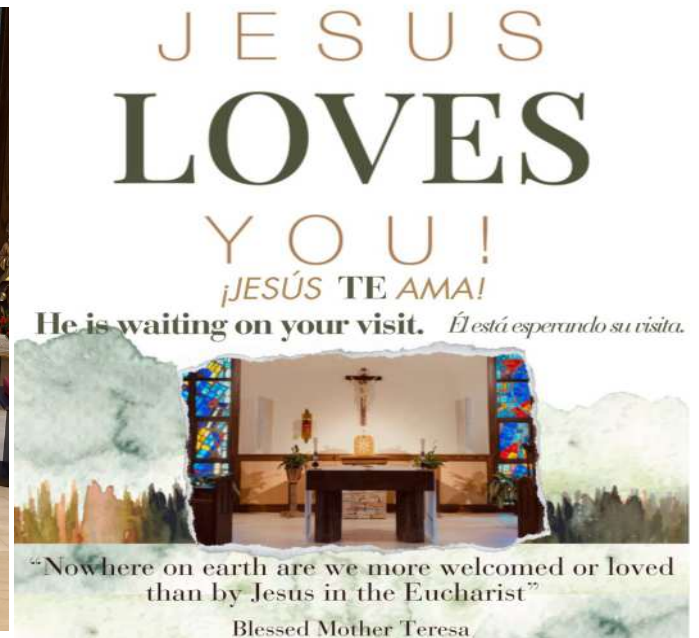
