Thank you for visiting the Delta Care -A- Van for COVID -19 Testing. Your test result was negative. A negative test result means that it is unlikely you have COVID-19 at the time you were tested.

Sometimes there are false negatives, which means you have the disease but the test doesn't detect it. If you have a fever, cough, or cold symptoms, you should remain home and minimize contact with others. If you are concerned about your symptoms, call your primary care provider.

If you were exposed to someone who was diagnosed with COVID-19, please remain in quarantine for 14 days from the time you were exposed to that person. A negative test cannot remove you out of quarantine, as you may become infectious between 2-14 days from the time you were exposed.

Please remember to continue to wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, wear a face mask in public settings and keep social distancing of at least 6 feet.
