Pray that our Children and Youth will experience God's love in a deep and vibrant way and that church camp will be a time of deepening relationships with Jesus and one another.

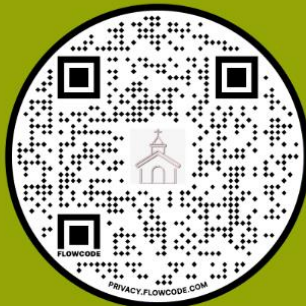

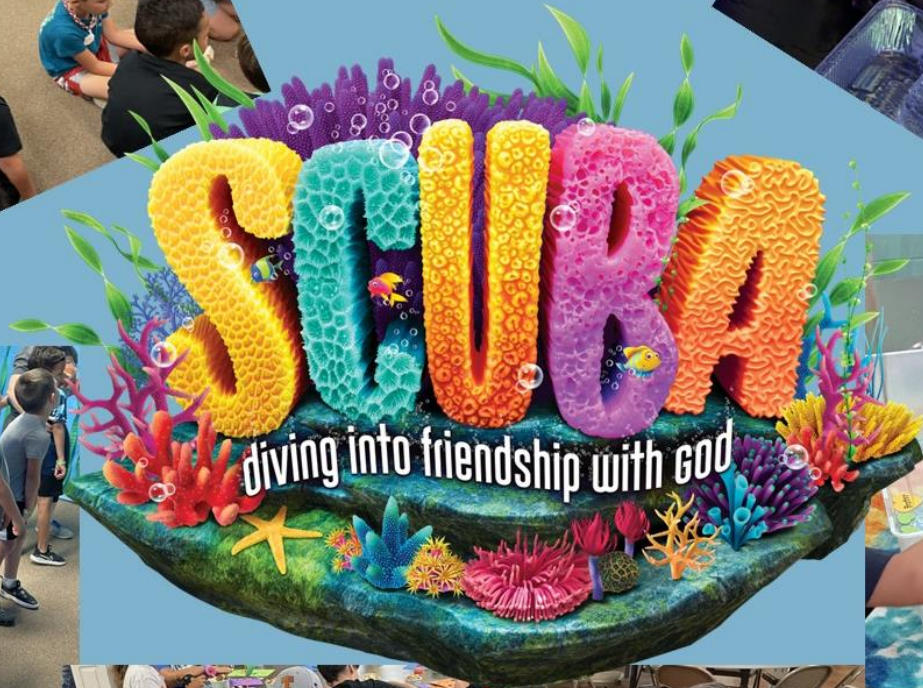
