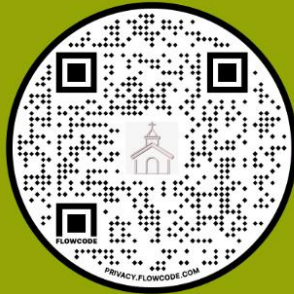
Vacation Bible School - June 17-20

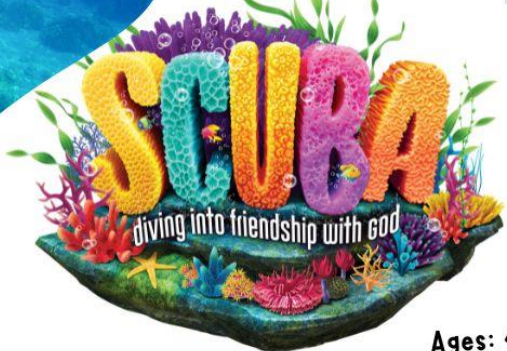
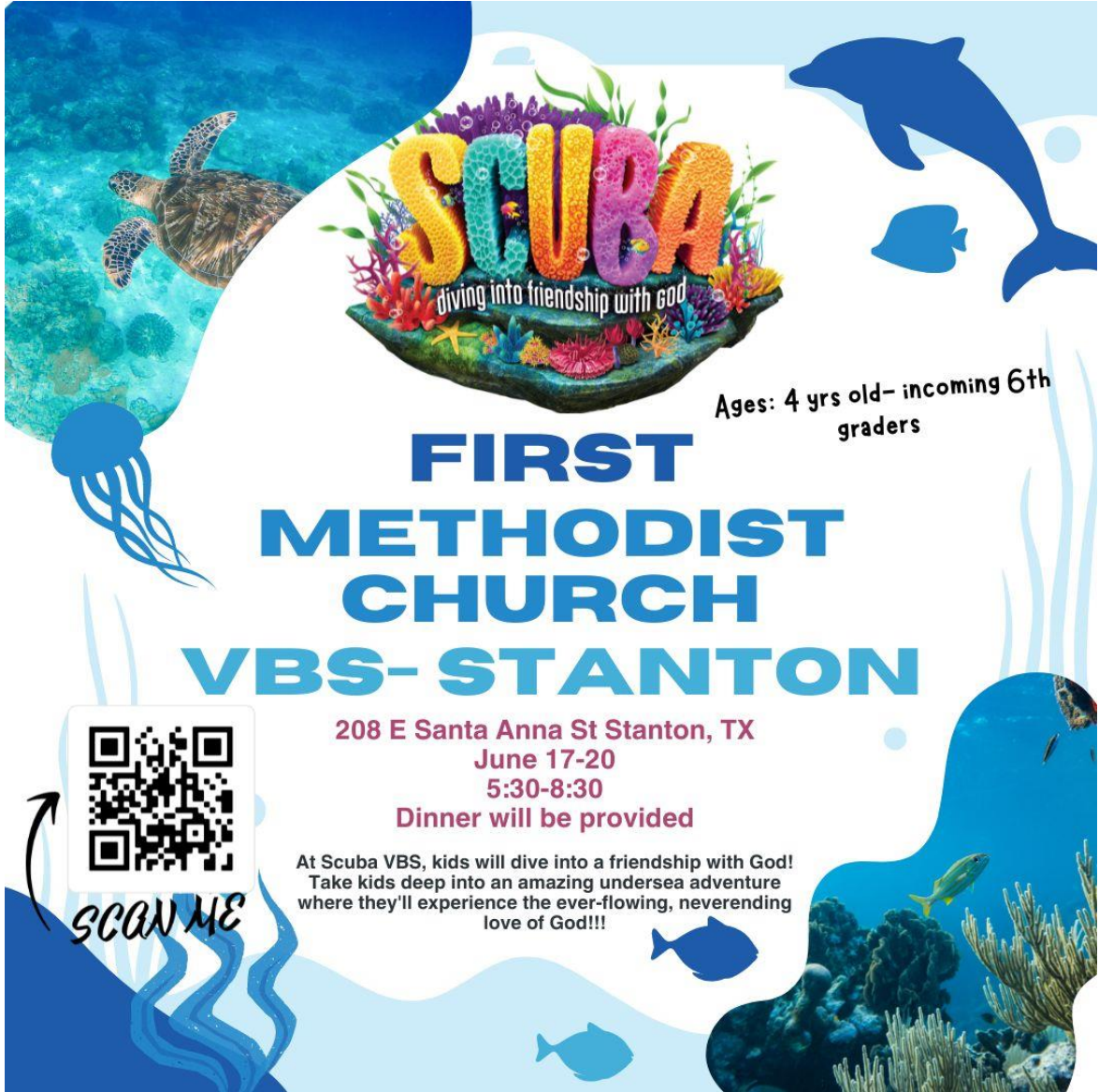
