# LETTER FROM PASTOR BOBBY

Greetings First Methodist Stanton Family!

## God Invites Himself Into Everyone's Lives

Last Month I preached a sermon on the story of Zacchaeus found in Luke 19:1-10. This story contains what many call the theme verse of Luke Gospel, Luke 19:10, which reads, "For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost." Just like with Jesus inviting himself into Zacchaeus' house for dinner, Jesus invites himself into our lives. He doesn't wait to be invited into our lives before offering each person the gift of his grace and love. We Methodist call this "Prevenient Grace." It is the grace of God that comes before we know Him and that leads us to know Him through the Holy Spirit.

I personally find it amazing that God invites Himself into the lives of every person that has lived, is alive, and will ever live. A self invitation goes against our sensibilities as modern Americans, but I think Jesus' example with Zacchaeus is instructive for us. God calls the church (we're the church, not the building) to go out into the world around us to help our neighbors awaken to the god who has already invited Himself into their lives. This sounds good, but the question of how we do this remains...

Wilma Stirl recently shared this devotional with me, and it offers the answer to how we help our neighbors awaken to a self-invited God.

## Hand It On!

"How can the church grow?" I hear this question all the time. Because my ministry is primarily with young adults, another question I get is "How do we get young people to come to our church?" My answer is always the same: "There is no gimmick or scheme that will lure people into the church, so stop trying to find one."

"Paul certainly didn't have one! Paul had a story to tell, and he told it to anyone who would listen. He told his story about Jesus in synagogues and market squares, in people's homes, along the roads, and on the high seas."

# LETTER FROM PASTOR BOBBY

"We have a story to tell—a compelling story of God's grace and love in Christ and how that grace and love frees us to be who God created us to be. So the question is not, 'How do we get people to come to us?' It's 'How do we go to them?' It's 'How do we get to them?' 'How can we build relationships?' The answer to all these is, 'Learn people's stories.', 'Tell our story.', 'Discover where God is at work in our lives.' This is proclaiming the good news and handing it on!'

Our stories of God's love and grace are the invitation we can offer to our neighbors. It is my prayer that we go out and share them. We have the greatest TRUE story in history working in our lives right now! The story of God's love and grace in your life is compelling, because God's love is already at work in your neighbor's life.

So church, who can you go and share your story with today?

We have some exciting things coming up for our children and youth ministries. We will have Vacation Bible School from June 15 th-June 18th. Be sure to invite anyone you know with children ages 4 years old to rising 6th graders to come and attend. 
# YOUTH MISSION TRIP RUIDOSO, NM


# **CONGRATULATIONS GRADUATES!**


Our Director of Family Life & Missions
