LEGISLATIVE REPORT- APRIL 2023

HB 709 - Proceeds Funding Motorcycle Safety Education by Rep. Yarkosky, has been assigned its committee pathway. The first committee that it has just been assigned and is now waiting to be heard is the Transportation and Modals Subcommittee. This Bill had it's first reading 3/7

And SB 838, the companion bill for HB 709, has also been filed and the first committee it will go to is the Senate Committee on Transportation. It has not been put on the agenda yet, however, we can start to contact the Senators on this committee and ask for their support of SB 838.


