The governor is also going as far as to call for a new legislative session, possibly next month, to address the vaccine mandates. A special election to fill the seat representing Florida's 20<sup>th</sup> Congressional District in the U.S. House will be held in 2022. The special election will fill the vacancy left Alcee Hastings (D), who died on April 6, 2021. HB 2573: Abate of Florida Safety and Education – Abate of Florida Safety and Education; Provides an appropriation for the Abate of Florida Safety and Education. APPOPRIATION: \$300,000; Appropriations Committee now formed. Chair: Jay Trumbull; Vice Chair: Lawrence McClure; Democratic Ranking Member: Nicholas Duran. The first redistricting plans emerging for the Republicancontrolled Legislature have been greeted calmly, maybe even welcomed by the outnumbered Democrats.



It is important that you contact your legislator about HB 2573 which is the bill for our Safety and Education money.

It is simple to do and takes only a few moments, if you can handle reading and writing emails, you can do this, trust me, everything you need is right here.

- Legislators email address
- All of the Florida House of Representatives email addresses have the same layout, this way you can always email them easily.

TALLAHASSEE --- House Redistricting Chairman Tom Leek hopes initial maps, with proposed congressional and legislative lines for the next decade, could be ready before the 2022 legislative session begins in January.

week, according to a schedule posted online. Gov. Ron DeSantis called the special legislative session to address issues related to COVID-19 mandates.

TALLAHASSEE --- For Gov. Ron DeSantis and many other Republicans, it has become an article of faith: People should not be required to wear masks or get vaccinated amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

That will be on display during the coming week as the GOP-controlled Legislature will hold a special session to push back against mask and vaccination mandates --- particularly mandates supported by the Biden administration.

TALLAHASSEE --- Thanksgiving week is usually one of the quietest times of the year in government, as offices clear out and people focus on family.

But for at least some faculty members and leaders at the University of Florida, this Thanksgiving week might not be so calm.

A university task force is scheduled to hold meetings Monday and Tuesday, as it continues grappling with a controversy that erupted after three political science professors were told they could not testify against the state in a lawsuit challenging a new elections law.

TALLAHASSEE --- To confront inflation, Gov. Ron DeSantis said Monday he will ask lawmakers next year to temporarily "zero out" state gas taxes.

Continuing to contrast his economic approach to the Biden White House, De-Santis said the approximately 25-cent-a-gallon "gas tax relief" proposal could save the average Florida family up to \$200 over a five- to six-month period, while reducing state revenue by more than \$1 billion. DeSantis wants lawmakers to approve it during the legislative session that starts Jan. 11.



Many years ago, we were riding along, when the rear end of the bike began to swerve around. It was a flat!

From previous years of experience with bicycles, motorcycles, and cages, we have always possessed a flat tire tool kit with patches, plugs, and a means to inflate. This has saved us hours of waiting for help and lots of money. Thankfully, most of the flats on the motorcycles and cages have been easy plug fixes with tubeless tires.

What are the some of the items one could be prepared with or do before riding?

- 1. Do you have enough gas?
- 2. Check the oil. Check for major leaks. Brakes working?
- 3. Tire wear and pressure...
- 4. Lights and horn working...
- 5. Anything look loose?
- 6. Rain gear, gloves, special footwear needed for the day?
- 7. Tool kit?

The Motorcycle Safety Foundation uses the acronym T-CLOCS: tires and wheels (T), controls (C), lights and electrics (L), oil and other fluids (O), chassis (C) and stands (S). (www.msf-usa.org)

The list could be endless! However, most of our riding involved major distances and most of our scoots were baggers.

We seem to spend our lives doing the right preparations for all the activities of life on this planet, rarely giving a thought of preparing for the biggest ride of our existence... the ride that we will take into eternity!


